Rules and regulations of the Rectorate of the UFS

1. COMPOSITION

Rector and Vice-Chancellor (Chairperson)
Vice-Rectors (including Senior Vice-Rector)
Registrar
Secretariat (Meeting Administration)

2. MEETINGS AND PROCEDURES

- a) At least half of the members of the Rectorate constitute a quorum.
- b) The Rectorate meets on a weekly basis, or as required, during the academic year, as indicated on the official calendar of the University.

3. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE RECTORATE

- 3.1 Matters that are urgent, require immediate attention and are of a sensitive nature, so that they cannot be held over to the next meeting of the ECS or UMC.
- 3.2 Mutual consultation and strategic conversation between members of the Rectorate.

 Consultation and strategic conversations may be aimed at matters related to planning or which are of an operational nature.
- 3.3 The testing of opinions and mutual provision of information by members of the Rectorate.
- 3.4 Advice on/or exchange of ideas regarding any matter that occurs within the portfolios of the Rectorate, for which time must be set aside within the cadre of senior management.
