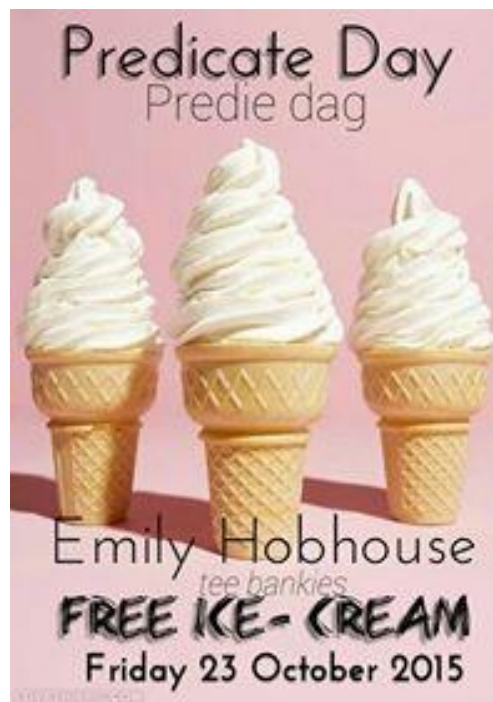
The first years of 2015
