2. CURRICULUM VITAE¹⁾

Otto Carl Heinrich Krause - journalist and political commentator was born on the 15th February 1930 in Bloemfontein. He received his education at Grey College, Bloemfontein and thereafter at Stellenbosch-, Oxford- and Yale Universities.

Mr Krause served as a journalist on the staff of Die Transvaler from 1956-1957, whereafter he joined Die Vaderland from 1957-1962. He was then appointed as editor of News/Check magazine, 1962-1970 and later on as editor of The SA Financial Gazette, 1977-1979. During 1979 he joined the Perskor Group as political writer.

3. ARRANGEMENT

The documents in this collection reflects the wide range of Mr Krause's interests and activities as a journalist.

The collection consists of unnumbered subjects files, which were divided into three main groupings, e.g. South Africa, Africa and World. The files within each main group were listed in alphabetical order.

This collection is in a good state of preservation and occupies 10,70 m shelving space.
