

Application: Requirements

The following requirements apply:

- 1. Only students registered at the UFS in 2015 as first-time undergraduate, full-time students in their first year of study may apply for the programme, i.e. Bloemfontein Campus and Qwaqwa Campus. UPP students in their second year (first year at Bfn campus) may apply. Students on the extended programme who have commenced their studies in July 2014 are still regarded as first years in January 2015 and may apply.
- 2. Fluency in English is essential due to the nature of the programme.
- 3. Satisfactory academic achievement in the first semester of 2015.
- 4. Satisfactory participation in Student/Residence Life programmes.
- 5. Indication of the candidate as a well-rounded individual.
- 6. Indication of a keen interest in and engagement of issues of leadership, diversity and citizenship.
- 7. Students aged between 18 and 26 will be considered.
- 8. No students with formal disciplinary cases pending or action taken against them, will be considered.
- 9. No students with criminal records will be considered.
- 10. No late or incomplete applications will be considered. **ONLY** electronic, online applications are allowed.
- 11. Commitment and submission to the policies, rules and regulations of the UFS.
- 12. Commitment and submission to management and regulations of the F1 L4C programme as required within policies, rules and regulations of the UFS.
- 13. Commitment and submission to South African rules and regulations of international engagement.
- 14. Willingness to be an ambassador of the UFS.
- 15. Any further requirements as may be indicated and formulated by the UFS.
- 16. Formal approval to join the programme from a candidate's guardians, if need be.
- 17. It is highly recommended that candidates who are not already in possession of a passport, should apply for one as soon as possible. Selected candidates should be able to supply a passport copy/ proof of application if/when they are invited for the panel interviews.
