

Biography: Prof Thuli Madonsela

Prof Thulisile ‘Thuli’ Madonsela, an advocate of the High Court of South Africa, is the Law Trust Chair in Social Justice and a Law professor at the Stellenbosch University, where she conducts and coordinates social justice research and teaches Constitutional and Administrative Law.

She is the founder of the Thuma Foundation, an independent democracy leadership and literacy public benefit organisation, and convener of the Social Justice M-Plan, a Marshall Plan-like initiative aimed at catalysing progress towards ending poverty and reducing inequality by 2030, in line with the National Development Plan (NDP) and Sustainable Development Goals (SGGs).

She is a monthly columnist for the *Financial Mail* and *City Press/Rapport*, and occasionally writes for other newspapers.
