NEW FIRST TIME ENTERING STUDENTS AND 2018 FIRST TIME ENTERING RENEWALS

Please find herewith information on how 2019 NSFAS allowances will be made available to students. This is relevant for the NSFAS General bursary fund only.

Allowances will differ according to the different accommodation types. The following are examples of how the amount of allowances and pay-out thereof will be administered:

1. STUDENTS STAYING IN CAMPUS RESIDENCES

Students will receive, apart from full tuition and on campus accommodation, the following allowances:

Rent will be paid up to a maximum of R32 000.00 per annum. This allowance amount will be determined during the private accommodation application process. The process for payments from March until November will be communicated in due course.

Note 1: NSFAS Guidelines: "In general, qualifying students whose home address is within a radius of 30km from the university campus would not be considered for an award for an accommodation allowance. These students qualify for travel allowance determined by the institution, up to a maximum of R10 000 in 2019. This includes a R2 750 incidental allowance."

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 1. Allowances for other NSFAS administered funding e.g. Funza Lushaka, Social Development etc. will be paid according to the donor's requirements. Any allowance may only be administered and transferred to students as per the terms and conditions of the funder. It may also mean that the allowances must be paid to pockets.
- 2. All qualifying registered NSFAS students will receive the first allowance amount, irrespective whether a NSFAS agreement have been singed yet. Further allowance payments will only be made after you have signed your NSFAS agreement and payment was received from NSFAS.

- 3. Allowances will be transferred to students' bank accounts through Fundi procedures.
- 4. Since the allowances will be provided in cash it is the student's responsibility to manage their allowances wisely and to use it for the purpose received for. NSFAS Circular 6 dated 21 January 2019: "The NSFAS allowance funding is to assist eligible students with funding for costs related to their studies such as books, accommodation, food and travel where applicable. In the process we want students to grow to be responsible citizens and take charge of their economic needs and responsibilities."
