

Application: Procedure and Schedule

Interested students download the F1 L4C Application Pack from http://kovsielife.ufs.ac.za/F1

Applicants **electronically** complete and submit the form, together with supporting documentation, as required on the above-mentioned website.

Any enquiries or correspondence can be e-mailed to <u>F1application@ufs.ac.za</u> Please do not e-mail the application to this address.

The application form will include questions pertaining to your interest and consideration of leadership, diversity and citizenship issues. Your Curriculum Vitae and **one** Letter of Reference must be included in the application, as indicated on the website.

The selection process will run in three phases, namely application by interested students (first round selection and listing as per academic results, July exams), achievements and student life participation (second round selection) and (third round and final F1 L4C team selection) presentations to panels by candidates selected after the second round.

An initial selection of 70 candidates will be made based on the standardised application form and indicated requirements.

These first round candidates will be invited to make oral presentations (MS PowerPoint Presentations) to a selection panel that will test communication skills, interest and consideration of leadership, diversity and citizenship issues. Five selection panels consisting of various faculty and other representatives will interview candidates.

A final selection of 30 candidates will be made based on the presentations and relevant indicators, such as academic results, leadership roles, student life involvement, holistic development and programme commitment of students.

The 30 successful candidates will be requested to complete the MBTI preference test with a view of establishing optimal teams.
