Maye Musk is an international best-selling author, dietitian, model, and speaker.

Her book, A Woman Makes a Plan, is available in 100 countries, including South Africa, and published in 30 languages.

Ms Musk has run her own nutrition business for more than 45 years in eight cities and three countries through counselling, speaking, consulting, writing, and media work. She has reached the peak in her field in three countries: the first Representative of the Consulting Dietitians of Southern Africa; President of the Consulting Dietitians of Canada; and Chair of the Nutrition Entrepreneurs, Academy of Dietetics and Nutrition. She also won the Outstanding Nutrition Entrepreneur Award in the USA. She was the first dietitian to be featured on a cereal box with her book, *Feel Fantastic*, published in 1996. She was also the first dietitian to have a website.

Ms Musk is the only dietitian to have taken the registration examination in three countries, once in Afrikaans, and once in imperial measurements.

She has travelled around the world, giving talks in Melbourne, Stockholm, Kiev, Budapest, Cannes, Beirut, and most of the major cities in the USA, Canada, and South Africa. She always includes sound nutritional advice in her speeches.

Ms Musk's research work in nutritional sciences started at the University of the Free State when she was accepted for a Diploma in Hospital Dietetics at the Universitas Hospital in Bloemfontein. The university then offered her a bursary for a Master of Science degree, which took four years. This degree is recognised at universities worldwide.

Me Maye Musk is die skrywer van internasionale topverkopers, asook 'n dieetkundige, model en spreker.

Haar boek, *A Woman Makes a Plan*, is beskikbaar in 100 lande, waaronder Suid-Afrika, en is in 30 tale gepubliseer.

Me Musk het vir meer as 45 jaar haar eie voedingsbesigheid in agt stede en drie lande bedryf deur berading, praatjies, konsultasie, skryf- en mediawerk. Sy het die toppunt van haar vakgebied in drie lande behaal: die eerste verteenwoordiger van die Raadgewende Dieetkundiges van Suider-Afrika; President van die Raadgewende Dieetkundiges van Kanada; en Voorsitter van die Voedingsentrepreneurs, Akademie vir Dieetkunde en Voeding. Sy het ook die toekenning as Uitnemende Voedingsentrepreneur in die VSA gewen. Sy was die eerste dieetkundige wat op 'n graankoshouer verskyn het met haar boek, *Feel Fantastic*, wat in 1996 gepubliseer is. Sy was ook die eerste dieetkundige met haar eie webwerf.

Me Musk is die enigste dieetkundige wat die registrasie-eksamen in drie lande afgelê het – een keer in Afrikaans, en een keer in imperiale afmetings.

Sy het al oor die wêreld heen gereis en toesprake gehou in Melbourne, Stockholm, Kiëf, Boedapest, Cannes, Beiroet en die meeste van die groot stede in die VSA, Kanada en Suid-Afrika. Sy gee altyd goeie raad oor voeding in haar toesprake.

Me Musk se navorsingswerk in voedingswetenskappe het by die Universiteit van die Vrystaat begin toe sy vir 'n Diploma in Hospitaaldieetkunde aan die Universitas Hospitaal in Bloemfontein aanvaar is. Sy het daarna 'n beurs vir 'n Magister in Natuurwetenskappe van die universiteit ontvang, wat vier jaar geduur het. Hierdie graad word wêreldwyd by universiteite erken.

M of Musk ke sengodi sa dibuka tse rekiswang ka mokgwa o itlhommeng pele lefatseng la matjhaba, setsebi sa dijo motlelara, le sebui.

Buka ya hae, A Woman Makes a Plan, e fumaneha dinaheng tse 100, ho kenyeletswa le Afrika Borwa, mme e hatisitswe ka dipuo tse 30.

Mof Musk o tsamaisitse kgwebo ya hae ya phepo ka dilemo tse fetang 45 metseng e robedi le dinaheng tse tharo ka ho fana ka keletso, ho bua, le ho ngola le ka mosebetsi wa media. O ile a fihlella sehlohlolo mosebetsing wa hae dinaheng tse tharo: ya pele Representative of the Consulting Dietitians of Southern Africa; President of the Consulting Dietitians of Canada; le Chair of the Nutrition Entrepreneurs, Academy of Dietetics and Nutrition. O boetse a hapa moputso wa Outstanding Nutrition Entrepreneur Award in the USA. E bile setsebi sa pele sa dijo sa ho bontshwa lebokosong la dijo-thollo ka buka ya hae, *Feel Fantastic*, e ileng ya hatiswa ka 1996. Hape e bile setsebi sa pele sa dijo se ileng sa ba le websaete.

Mof Musk ke yena setsebi sa pele sa dijo se ileng sa etsa ngodiso ya ditlhatlhobo dinaheng tse tharo, hanngwe ka Afrikaanse, le hanngwe ka ditekanyo tsa imperial.

Hape o ile a kena maetong ho potoloha lefatshe, a fana ka dipuo Melbourne, Stockholm, Kiev, Budapest, Cannes, Beirut, le ditoropong tse kgolo tsa USA, Canada, le Afrika Borwa. Ka dinako tsohle o kenyeletsa diketelo mabapi le phepo dipuong tsa hae.

Mosebetsi wa diphuputso wa Mof Musk disaenseng tsa dijo o qadile Yunivesithi ya Freistataha a amohela Diploma ya Hospital Dietetics mane Universitas Hospital mona Bloemfontein. Yunivesithi e ile ya mo neha basari bakeng sa Master of Science degree, e ileng ya nka dilemo tse nne. Degree ena e amohelwa le ho dumelwa ke diyunivesithi lefatsheng ka bophara.

Maye Musk ungumbhali wezincwadi osezingeni lomhlaba futhi izincwadi zakhe zithengwa ubuthaphuthaphu, ubuye abe ungoti wokudla, abe uzime, aphinde abe isikhulumi esiqavile.

Incwadi yakhe ethi 'A Woman Makes a Plan' itholakala emazweni ayikhulu [100], neNingizimu Afrikha ingenye yawo, kanti futhi yona le ncwadi ishicilelwe ngezilimi ezingamashumi amathathu [30].

Usebe undabuzekwayo emazweni amathathu emukhakheni wakhe: ube Ubuso bokuqala be- Consulting Dietitians of Southern Africa; waba uMengameli we- Consulting Dietitians ezweni laseCanada; waphinde waba uSihlalo Wosomabhizinisi Abaphethe Ezokudla esikoleni i-Academy of Dietetics and Nutrition. Uphinde wahlaabana ngendondo eyaziwa ngele-Outstanding Nutrition Entrepreneur Award ezweni laseMelika. Ungungoti wezokudla wokuqala ukuthi akhangiswe esikhangisweni sokudla ngencwadi yakhe esihloko sithi 'Feel Fantastic', neyashicilelwa ngonyaka we-1996. Akugcini lapho, uphinde waba ungoti wokuqala wezokudla ukuba nekhasi lakhe kwikhmpyutha, phecelezi i-Website.

UNkszn Musk ongusosayensi wokudla uye kuphela oseke wathatha izivivinyo zokurejista ibhizinisi emazweni amathathu, kukhona ezazingolimi lwesiBhunu, kanti ezinye zaba ngezinye izilimi.

UNkszn Musk usethubeleze umhlaba ehamb' ethula izinkulumo ezihlabahlosile, usehambele emadolobha afana ne-Melbourne, iStockholm, iKiev, iBudapest, iCannes, iBeruit, kanye namanye amadolobha amakhulu eMelika, eCanada, naseNingizimu Afrikha. Uhlezi eshumayela ivangeli lolwazi lwezokudla uma ethula izinkulumo zakhe ezihlabahlosile.

Umsebenzi wocwaningo kaNkszn Musk kwezesayensi yokudla waqala eNyuvesi yaseFree State ngesikhathi ethola isikhala seziqu ze-Diploma ezifundweni ze-Hospital Dietetics eSibhedlela sayo le Nyuvesi esaziwa ngele-Universitas Hospital nesizinze edolobheni iBloemfontein. Inyuvesi yabe isimugixabeza ngomfundaze ukuqhuba izifundo zeMaster's kwezeSayensi, nokwamthatha iminyaka emine ukuyiphothula [4]. Lezo ziqu zakhe zinconywa emanyuvesi ahlukahlukene emhlabeni jikelele.

THE QUARTET OF PEACE

The Quartet of Peace is the name given to two violins, a viola, and a cello made in Cape Town in 2010 by the violin maker, Brian Lisus. He dedicated each to one of South Africa's four Nobel peace laureates – Albert Luthuli, Desmond Tutu, FW de Klerk, and Nelson Mandela – and called them Freedom, Peace, Reconciliation and Hope, respectively. These are exceptionally beautiful instruments with a rich, deep glow, and because they were made to be played together, the sound of the quartet is distinctive and warm, matching the beauty of the instruments. The instruments were first unveiled and heard in 2013.

It is with great pride that the Odeion String Quartet will be performing on the instruments during the graduation ceremony.

MISSION




