SASBCP 2026 CONFERENCE | TERMS & CONDITIONS

The South African Society for Basic and Clinical Pharmacology Conference (hereafter “SASBCP 2026”) is hosted by UFS Pharmacology Department (hereafter “Host”) and organised by K.I.T. Group - African Agenda (hereafter “Secretariat”).

REGISTRATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Once the registrant has received email confirmation of registration, the registration is a confirmed commitment subject to the cancellation terms below.
2. Full payment for registration fees is required within 10 working days of invoice.
 - 2.1. Payments must be made to “UFS Sundry Debtors.
 - 2.2. Payments must be made in South African Rand (ZAR).
 - 2.3. Any short payment resulting from bank charges and/or exchange rate fluctuations will be charged back to the registrant.
3. Cancellations must be received in writing by the Secretariat. The email address is registrationcpt@kit-group.org. Non-attendance at SASBCP 2026 (for any reason) without a written and acknowledged cancellation does not imply any release from financial obligations.
4. Cancellation fees will be imposed as follows:
 - 4.1. Registrants that cancel 60 days or more (up to 09 July 2026) prior to the start of SASBCP 2026 will receive a full refund minus a 10% administration fee.
 - 4.2. Registrants that cancel between 59 and 30 days prior to the start of SASBCP 2026 (between 10 July and 07 August 2026) will be refunded 50% of the amount paid; if fees are outstanding the registrant will be liable for 50% of the amount due.
 - 4.3. No refunds will be provided for no-shows or registrants that cancel within 30 days of the start of SASBCP 2026 (from 8 August 2026), and the registrant will be liable for the full amount due.
5. Registrations are transferable to another person only if the Secretariat is informed in writing. The email address is registrationcpt@kit-group.org.
6. Registrations may not be shared, i.e., shared name badges will not be issued, and name badges may not be shared with or loaned to others.

DATA PROCESSING CONSENT



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We are committed to protecting your privacy and the security of the personal data you provide to participate in SASBCP 2026. The following information will assist you to be fully informed before you submit any personal data. Please review the following and give your consent for your personal data to be processed.

What is personal data?

You will be required to submit personal data, including contact and demographic information that identifies you personally (e.g. name, address, email address, phone number, etc) to participate in SASBCP 2026.

The Secretariat will use this information for the following purposes: (a) enabling your SASBCP 2026 participation; (b) communicating SASBCP 2026-related information to you; (c) marketing SASBCP 2026 news and opportunities you may be interested in; and (d) sharing limited personal data with third parties that perform SASBCP 2026 services on behalf of the Host and the Secretariat.

Why are we processing your personal data?

We require your personal data to facilitate your participation in SASBCP 2026. This could include registering for the conference, submitting an abstract, or purchasing a sponsorship/exhibition package.

Other parties that will have access to your personal data.

Your personal data will only be shared with third parties in order to process your registration, abstract submission, or sponsorship/exhibition booking, and facilitate your participation in SASBCP 2026; this could include but is not limited to accommodation suppliers, exhibition services suppliers, transport service providers, and SASBCP 2026 sponsors and exhibitors. Third parties that contact you post- SASBCP 2026 are required by the Secretariat to offer you the option to “opt out” of communications.

How long will we store your personal data?

The Host and Secretariat may use this information for as long as they remain active in conducting any of the above purposes.

- Fire, flood, drought, water shortages, or adverse weather conditions
