



ADDENDUM

POLICY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF THE FREE STATE ON PLACEMENT OF STUDENTS IN JUNIOR RESIDENCES ON THE BLOEMFONTEIN CAMPUS, QWAQWA CAMPUS AND SOUTH CAMPUS

As a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic, it is recommended that:

- The deliverable to reach 65% First-Time-Entering (FTEN) students in on-campus junior residences by 2022, be amended to 2023 (paragraph 2.4 of the Policy).
- The gradual increase of the number of FTEN students in on-campus junior residences for the period 2020 – 2022 (paragraph 5.2 of the Policy), be amended to 2021 – 2023, as follows:
 - 50% (FIFTY PERCENT) for the 2021 Academic Year;
 - 60% (SIXTY PERCENT) for the 2022 Academic Year; and
 - 65% (SIXTY FIVE PERCENT) for the 2023 Academic Year.

REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE RENEWAL OF PLACEMENT IN JUNIOR RESIDENCES, BLOEMFONTEIN CAMPUS

As a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic, it is recommended that:

- Senior Students, excluding FTEN students: For 2020/2021 the October / November 2019 results will be used as the criteria. (Paragraph 3.2.1 of the Regulations)
- Current FTEN students: No academic criteria will be applied. Current FTEN students will have the opportunity to indicate their intent to return to their respective residences in 2021. (Paragraph 3.2.2 of the Regulations)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: REGULATIONS CONCERNING RENEWAL OF PLACEMENT IN JUNIOR RESIDENCES, BLOEMFONTEIN CAMPUS

- 50% Capacity for returning students will remain the target for 2021 (paragraph 1).
- October / November 2019 results will be used to calculate the academic merit of a senior student (paragraph 3).
