

ou have a three year diploma in Theology and have been in the ministry for a while. You would like to develop your theological knowledge and your ministerial skills, but you cannot afford to attend a university on a full-time basis.

If this description fits you, then the Advanced Diploma in Theology, which is offered over a period of two years, might be exactly what you are looking for. If you enrol for this Advanced Diploma, you will enhance your ministerial skills and develop new insights in no less than seven theological disciplines: Old Testament, New Testament, Systematic Theology and Ethics, Church History, Practical Theology, Missiology and Religion Studies. In your final semester you will also have the opportunity to conduct a research project.

You can do the Advanced Diploma while you are working, because you only need to attend lectures **once every three weeks** – on a Friday afternoon, from **12:00–18:00**.

Here is a sample of the kind of issues that you will be studying in the seven disciplines:

OLD TESTAMENT

- The exposition of selected passages in the Pentateuch
- The interpretation of the Pentateuch
- The exposition of selected passages from the Prophetic literature
- The interpretation of the Prophetic literature
- The exposition of selected passages from the Writings
- The interpretation of the Writings

NEW TESTAMENT

- Reading the New Testament in Africa
- Reading through the ages (historical perspective)
- Reading for meaning (hermeneutics)
- Reading in practice (exegesis)
