THE UFS SHEPHERD CENTRE OFFERS THE FOLLOWING SHORT LEARNING PROGRAMMES:



1 CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP IN CONTEMPORARY CONTEXT (TCLC1501S)

- Six to eight weeks programme on learning Level 5.
- Focuses on understanding the essence of leadership particularly from a Christian perspective. The approach to leadership studies in this SLP is contextual because even though Biblical understanding of leadership is essential, it is engaged in the context of African context and developments in the organizational leadership studies
- Requirements for admission: National Senior Certificate or an equivalent achievement, would be beneficial but is not a requirement.

2 EFFECTIVE BIBLE TEACHING TO CHILDREN (TEBT1501S)

- Six to eight weeks programme on learning Level 5.
- Focuses on providing basic knowledge to plan and implement an effective biblical ministry to and with children.
- Requirements for admission: National Senior Certificate or an equivalent achievement, would be beneficial but is not a requirement.

3 INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE (TBIB1502S)

- Six to eight weeks programme on learning Level 5.
- Focuses on the introduction to Biblical Literature. The nature of the Bible is explained, with a focus on the fact that the Bible gives us knowledge, shows us how to live, reveals the way of salvation, reveals God and is an inspired document.
- Requirements for admission: Grade 12 (National Senior Certificate or equivalent).

4 CHRISTIAN RITUAL AS A VERBAL AND NON-VERBAL PHENOMENON (TDCR1502S)

- Twelve week programme on learning Level .
- Focuses on the introduction to rituals as powerful verbal and non-verbal phenomena that can be used to create contextual, transcultural- and countercultural worship events.
- Requirements for admission: Grade 12 (National Senior Certificate or equivalent).

5 PRACTICAL THEOLOGY IN A FAST-CHANGING ENVIRONMENT (TDPT1502S)

- Twelve week programme on learning Level 5.
- Focuses on introduction to Practical Theology both as a discipline and basis for effective Christian ministry.
- Requirements for admission: Grade 12 (National Senior Certificate or equivalent).

6 BURIAL RITES IN THE AFRICAN CONTEXT (TDBR1502S)

- Twelve week programme on learning Level 5.
- Focuses on grieving, mourning, and funeral rites in the African context. African spirituality and worship will also be studied.
- Requirements for admission: Grade 12 (National Senior Certificate or equivalent).

PROVIDENCE AND FINANCIAL PLANNING FOR PASTORS (TPFF1602S)

- Twelve week programme on learning Level 6.
- Focuses on exploring the theological relationship between the Bible and financial management and equips them with the necessary knowledge and skills to manage their budget, debt and investments while planning for retirement.
- Requirements for admission: NQF Level 5 qualification and two years of ministry experience.

8 INTERPRETING THE BIBLE: A HISTORICAL OVERVIEW AND A PRACTICAL EXECUTION (TBIB1602S)

- Twelve week programme on learning Level 6.
- Focuses on be introduction to the history, theory and principles of exegesis and hermeneutics as basic tools for Biblical interpretation.
- Requirements for admission: Grade 12 (National Senior Certificate or equivalent), and Completion of the Introduction to the Bible SLP (TBIB1502S).
