- How are you currently involved in your church? (100 words)
- Where did you acquire computer skills (100 words)?
- Where will you get access to a computer, the internet and enough data (100 words)?

The course is presented online, twice yearly over six weeks, with a virtual contact session every Thursday between 17:00 – 19:00. To complete the short learning programme successfully, you must complete four assignments. Upon completion you will receive a competency based short learning programme certificate from the University of the Free State.
