## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Students may be admitted to the Honours degree in Criminology if they have:

- (i) A Bachelor's degree and 96 credits in Criminology;
- (ii) Passed the Bachelor's degree with an average mark of at least 60%;
- (iii) Obtained a mark of at least 65% in the **research proposal** for KRIM 3714 or in an equivalent research report;
- (iv) Passed the remaining undergraduate Criminology modules with an average mark of at least 60%;

Admission is subject to departmental approval on the basis of the admission requirements, the Test of Academic Literacy for Post graduate students (TALPS), sustained high academic standards at undergraduate level and, in cases where more than two years have elapsed since the awarding of the preliminary qualification, to selection criteria determined by the department. Please apply by 13<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

## **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

Applicants must fill in the application form and attach the following:

- 1. The results of the TALPS test. Students must arrange to write the test following the procedure on the attached document.
- 2. An official study record.
