

TEST OF ACADEMIC LITERACY FOR POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS [TALPS]

Everything you need to know is in this document; please read through it carefully.

Procedure for the arrangement/registration of a TALPS test for 2018

- Please note: this is an ICELDA test; it is not a test of the University of the Free State.
- Also note that our office hours are not fixed; therefore, please communicate via email.
- All test bookings must be confirmed via email by completing the registration form below and sending it with proof of payment to <u>talps@ufs.ac.za</u>.
- The test may be used as part of the procedure to process applications for postgraduate study, but usually does not contribute more than 15-20% if used for admission purposes.
- You do not need to prepare for the test. You are advised to consult the example test available at http://icelda.sun.ac.za/ to get an idea of what the test looks like.
- A student can repeat a test (if necessary) only after three months have passed.

1) The required fee (R110) must be deposited into the ICELDA entity at either:

TAKE NOTE THAT PROOF OF PAYMENT MUST BE PROVIDED TOGETHER WITH THE REGISTRATION FORM.

- Normally, it takes a week or two to process the results. More time may be needed in the case of large test groups. The results are forwarded directly to the contact persons in the academic departments concerned and are not communicated by ICELDA to the students or test takers.
 Students may then request the results from their academic departments.
- It is also possible for departments of the UFS campus to arrange for alternative dates and venues for selected groups of students; please contact <u>talps@ufs.ac.za</u> to make such an arrangement.
