CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR BA HONOURS BURSARIES

This memo serves to announce two (2) available bursary opportunities for candidates to pursue full-time the BA Honours in English degree in the Department of English at the QwaQwa Campus of the University of the Free State. The bursaries, presented under the auspices of the Afromontane Research Institute, will require students to focus their research essay on the nodal area of "Visual cultures of the Maloti Afromontane" – a research project led by researchers in the Department of English.

Value of bursaries: R40 000 for 1 academic year

Requirements: You should **either** have a BA degree **or** be in your final year of the BA degree. In both cases, you must have English as one of your subjects.

As a general rule, students are admitted to postgraduate studies and to each higher level of postgraduate study only if they fulfil the university requirements for registration, have completed the preliminary degree with a mark of 60% or more, and are accepted to the course they wish to study by the applicable academic head of department.

How to apply: Just indicate in your cover application letter for the BA Honours in English degree that you wish to be considered for the bursary.
