Pumla Dineo Gqola is the feminist author of *What is slavery to me? Postcolonial/slave memory in post-apartheid South Africa*, published by WitsPress in 2010, and *A Renegade called Simphiwe* published under the Melinda Ferguson Books Joburg imprint at Jacana in 2013. She is Associate Professor of African literary and gender studies at the University of the Witwatersrand. Gqola has an active teaching and research interest in African, postcolonial and feminist literatures of the African world, and has published widely on slave memory, Black Consciousness literature, post-apartheid public culture and African feminisms. She has MA degrees from the Universities of Cape Town and Warwick (UK), and a PhD from the Ludwig Maximilian University of Munich.
