Please note that we only accept portfolios via email.

Fine Arts is not simply a fieldof study, but a vocation. An education in Fine Arts contributes to the development of a student's creativity, imagination, innovative thinking, critical thinking, and visual literacy. A wide variety of career possibilities await the graduate, primarily in the worlds of art, advertising, museums, and education. The four year degree involves Drawing, New Media, Photography, Painting, Printmaking, Sculpture and Installation, and Art History and Image Studies. An additional mandatory elective (such as a language) is also completed within the firsttwo years of study. Alternative and new media is embraced in the department's multi-disciplinary approach. Students are taught by practising artists who are expected to participate and excel at local, national, and international levels. See www.ufs.ac.za for more.

### All prospective Fine Arts students are required to:

- First apply for admission to the University of the Free State either online (https://apply.ufs. ac.za) or in hard copy by completing the general application forms available to download (www. ufs.ac.za) and mailing it to: The Application Office, P.O. Box 339, Bloemfontein, 9300.
  - There are specific matric exemption requirements that you must meet to study at any South African university. Please familiarize yourself with these requirements available in the Prospetus that can be found online (www.ufs.ac.za).
- The minimum requirements to be considered for Fine Arts are:
  - Matric exemption requirements mentioned above (required of all university students)
  - An AP score of at least 30
  - 50% for language of instruction
  - Compulsory National Benchmark Test
  - A Portfolio
- Submit this **Selection Form** and **Portfolio** by **30 September** via email to FineArts@ufs.ac.za.
- No application will be considered without the Selection Form and Portfolio.
- Even if the student was successful during the departmental selection process and notified as such, the student is only accepted for the programme on condition that she/he has obtained admission to the University of the Free State at the time when studies commence (final admission to the University depends on the final grade 12 results, will be notified by the university on the final decision to whether to admit you).



## portfolio Prequirements

The department is lenient with regards to what is submitted in the portfolio and the following are only suggestions. However, the portfolio must consist of no less than eight works of art and no more than ten. The main consideration is that the artworks must be of a high quality technically as well as conceptually.

Please note that we only accept digital portfolios. You need to submit photographs in jpeg or pdf format as attachments with this selection form.

- One drawing (A2 size) in any black and white medium that portrays form and space (still life, landscape or buildings)
- One drawing (A2 size) in any colour medium (pastel, coloured pencil) that portrays form and space (still life, landscape or buildings)
- Two drawings (A2 size) in any black and white medium of the human figur (preferably observed from a live model and not a photograph)
- One self-portrait (A2 size) observed from a mirror in any black and white medium
- Three other art orks in any medium of your choice. If submitting any three dimensional works (sculpture or installations) please send photographs taken from at least three different angles
- The digital files should be clearly named with our name and title of the work.
- The digital files should be maximum 2MB eac
