Die Odeion Skool vir Musiek bied op Donderdagaand, 8 September 'n spesiale gedenkkonsert ter ere van ontslape prof Derek Ochse aan. Hierdie legendariese dosent en violis is in 1979 as senior lektor aan die UV Departement Musiek aangestel en later tot medeprofessor bevorder. Benewens sy ampte as konsertmeester van die PACOFS orkes en later die Vrystaat Simfonieorkes, neem hy ook die inisiatief in die stigting van die *Consortium Musicum*, die UV Klavierkwartet, die Ou Presidensie Konserltreeks, die Odeion Sinfonia en die *Odeion Musik Fest*. Hy was ook eerste violis en hoof van die Odeion Strykkwartet vanaf 1991 – 1999. Aan die einde van 1999 tree Derek by die UV af, maar speel hy steeds 'n hoogs invloedryke en belangrike rol in die musieklewe van Bloemfontein en die Vrystaat.

DEREK OCHSE MEMORIAL CONCERT**8 September 2016****Odeion****19:30**

The Odeion School of Music will present a special memorial concert in honour of the late prof Derek Ochse on Thursday evening, 8 September. This legendary lecturer and violinist was appointed senior lecturer at the UFS Department of Music in 1979 and later promoted to associate professor. Apart from being the concert master of the PACOFS Orchestra, and later of the Free State Symphony Orchestra, he took the initiative in founding the *Consortium Musicum*, the UFS Piano Quartet, the Old Presidency Concert Foundation, the Odeion Sinfonia, and the *Odeion Music Fest*. Also, he was the first violinist and head of the Odeion String Quartet from 1991 - 1999. Derek retired from his university position at the end of 1999, but continued to play an extremely influential and important role within the musical life of Bloemfontein and of the Free State Province.

Artists who will perform during the concert include Sharon de Kock (violin), Michael Haller (cello), Anmari van der Westhuizen (cello), Nicol Viljoen (piano), Jan Beukes (organ).
