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





Phases of the serial drawing model

Initial/<u>chaotic</u> phase {sessions ± 01 – 04 }:
 Projection of problem unto medium & therapist =

Externalisation/giving visible shape to inner problem.


- Middle/<u>struggle</u> phase {sessions ± 05 08}: Struggle between "good" & "bad" {opposites}.
- Termination/<u>solution</u> phase {sessions ± 09 12}:Themes of healing will appear

Healing = integration of pain and ego, behaviour & moods not directed by unconscious complexes {daemons}; Healing ≠ utopia



3.1 CHAOTIC PHASE

- Give a view of the child's internal world
- Reflect feelings of hopelessness
- Represent a vehicle for establishing the initial contact with the therapist





3.2 STRUGGLE PHASE

- Expression of emotion
- Struggle between ambivalent feelings
- A deeper relationship with the therapist develops
- The disclosure of a deep issue




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3.3 RESOLUTION PHASE
