Adeshina Afolayan teaches philosophy at the University of Ibadan, Nigeria. His areas of specialisation include African cultural studies, African political philosophy and philosophy of modernity. He was a 2023-2024 Founder’s Fellow at the National Humanities Centre, North Carolina. He is the author of *Philosophy and National Development in Nigeria* (2018); editor of *Auteuring Nollywood* (2014) and *Identities, Histories and Values in Postcolonial Nigeria* (2021); the coeditor of the *Palgrave Handbook of African Philosophy* (2017), *Pentecostalism and Politics in Africa* (2018), *Indigenous Knowledge Systems and Development in Africa* (2020), *Pathways to Alternative Epistemologies in Africa* (2021), and *Global Health, Humanity and the COVID-19 Pandemic* (2023). His current project interrogates the critical engagements between African philosophy and popular culture in postcolonial Nigeria.
