

BIOGRAPHY – PROF SANDRA LIEBENBERG

Prof Sandra Liebenberg is a Distinguished Professor and holder of the HF Oppenheimer Chair in Human Rights Law at the University of Stellenbosch. As a scholar, she enjoys considerable international recognition, as attested to by her B1 NRF rating. She has published four books as author or editor; 32 chapters in books; and 32 articles in peer-reviewed journals and has delivered plenary or keynote presentations at numerous national and international conferences. She received her LLD from the University of Witwatersrand in 2011.

In addition to the various boards and committees she has served or serves on, Prof Liebenberg recently concluded a four-year term as a member and, from 2019 to 2020, as deputy chair, of the United Nations Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights. Prof Liebenberg is the founder of the Socio-Economic Rights Project of the Community Law Centre of the University of the Western Cape.
