Nosipho Goba is an LLD candidate specialising in Constitutional Law and Philosophy of Law at the University of the Free State. She holds the LLB (UP) and LLM (UP) degrees. Nosipho's work draws on Critical Race Theory and decolonial intellectual traditions in the legal academy as well as developing scholarship in critical race spatial theory, feminist theory, queer theory and social and legal geography.
