He is an NRF Category C2-rated Researcher and the UNDP Human Rights Research Chair, Faculty of Law, National University of Law. He has been a visiting scholar at the Van Vollenhoven Institute, Leiden Law School, University of Leiden, The Netherlands, in 2022; the Law and Development Research Group, University of Antwerp, Belgium, in 2016 and the Cegla Centre for Interdisciplinary Research in Law, University of Tel-Aviv, Israel in 2015. His research interest combines human rights and development with a niche focus on the right to development and socioeconomic and cultural rights, wherein he has published extensively, including books, book chapters and journal articles. He is a member of the Law and Development Research Network, Associate Editor of the Lesotho Law Journal and Advisory Board Member of the International Journal of Ethiopia Legal Studies (IJELS).
