Dikgang Ernest Moseneke was born in 1947. He is the Deputy Chief Justice of the Republic of South Africa and a Justice of the Constitutional Court. Prior to this, he was a judge of the High Court in Pretoria. As political prisoner, he served ten years on Robben Island, during which time he completed his Bluris and LLB degrees through Unisa. He practised as an attorney and later as an advocate at the Johannesburg and Pretoria Bars. He served on the technical committee which drafted the 1993 Interim Constitution of South Africa. From 1995 to 2001 he pursued a full-time corporate career, which ended when he was elevated to the bench. He has served in several community-based organisations and is also closely associated with tertiary education, currently being the Chancellor of the University of the Witwatersrand. He holds four honorary doctorates and is a recipient of numerous other honorary awards.
