He has been published extensively on these subjects in international journals and other publications. He is co-author of A Guide to Intellectual Property Law in Botswana (2001). Prof. Kiggundu has acted as legal trade adviser to the Government of Swaziland and drafted the Swaziland Companies Bill 2004. He is also a research fellow in the Department of Mercantile Law at the University of South Africa.
