Prof. Jonathan Jansen is the Vice-Chancellor of the University of the Free State (since 2009) and a former Dean of Education at the University of Pretoria (2001-2007). He is a former high school biology teacher who received his undergraduate education at UWC (BSc), his teaching credentials at UNISA (HED, BEd) and his postgraduate education in the USA (MS, Cornell; PhD, Stanford). His most recent books are "Knowledge in the Blood" (2009, Stanford University Press), which was selected by the Library Journal in the USA for the list of Best Books of 2009, and he has co-authored "Diversity High: Class, Color, Character and Culture in a South African High School" (2008, University Press of America). He holds honorary doctorates in Education awarded by the University of Edinburgh (UK) and Cleveland State University (USA). He is the current President of the South African Institute of Race Relations, and recently elected fellow of the American Educational Research Association (AERA) and the Academy of Science for the Developing World (TWAS).
