

Application for BSc:Honours in Chemistry

To be considered for BSc:Honours in Chemistry, a student must have a BSc degree. Other prerequisites include first year mathematics (MATM1614 or MATM1534, plus MATM1624 or MATM1544 on the UFS campus)

An average mark of 60% in all third-year modules CHEM3713 + CHEM3711, CHEM3733 + CHEM3731, CHEM3723 + CHEM3721 and CHEM3743 + CHEM3741 or equivalent NQF Exit Level 7 modules) is needed. **Note also that the programme starts annually at mid-January.**

To apply for Honours, the applicant need to email his/her official mid-year results and the completed application form below to Me AS van Rooyen at vRooyenAS@ufs.ac.za before the 15 October 2018. Selection will take place before the 31 October and all applicants will be informed about the outcome of the selection process. This selection to the course is only provisional, and final admission will only be made after proof of a final 60 % average for all third-year modules has been received.

On admission, the successful students can apply/register via the official UFS channels for admission to the UFS.

Application via any other way will result in an unsuccessful outcome for a candidate.
