  - Recent Curriculum Vitae (CV)
  - Motivation letter (not more than 300 words) explaining why you should be accepted into the programme
- Returning DiMTEC students who completed their PGD within 12 months and obtained an overall average score of 60% need to only complete the DV3 Form and register to proceed with their Master's degree
