OVERVIEW

With a PhD in Disaster Management, you will become an esteemed expert in your chosen study area after completing extensive supervised research. You are expected to present a paper at a recognised national or international conference and to publish at least one article in an accredited journal.

DURATION

Minimum two years, maximum five years

APPLICATION PROCESS

PhD applications are open throughout the year and first-time registration is at any time throughout the year. To qualify, you need a master's degree at NQF Level 9 in any qualification field. You must have obtained 65% in your master's thesis. If you did not obtain your masters in a disaster management-related qualification, you may be required to register for some modules in the UFS-DiMTEC PGDip or masters programme for non-degree purposes.

Apply online on the UFS application portal. Attach all documents, including your concept note, in one file. If the concept note and application are accepted, you will be advised to register and be invited to present your proposal or extended concept note.

Presentations are three times a year (January/May/October).
