APPLICATION PROCESS

- PhD applications are open throughout the year, and first-time registration is anytime throughout the year. To qualify, you need a Master's degree at NQF level 9 in any field of qualification. You must have obtained 65% in your Master's thesis. If you did not obtain your Masters in a disaster management-related qualification, you might be required to register for some modules in the UFS-DiMTEC PGDip or Masters programme for non-degree purposes.
- Apply Online at <https://apply.ufs.ac.za/Application/Start>. Attach all documents, including your Concept Note, in one file. If the Concept Note and application are accepted, you will be advised to register and invited to present your proposal or extended concept note.

DURATION

- Minimum 2 years, maximum 6 years
- PhD proposal presentations are three times a year (January/May/October).
