UFS ICS100 - 400 Short Course SAQUA Accreditation

The following is applicable for SAQUA accredited Incident Command System (ICS) short course training underwritten by UFS-DiMTEC.

ICS training courses 100, 200, 300 and 400 are accredited at NQF level 5 with 5 credits each. These courses consist of a theoretical training of 2 credits for each course. The additional 3 credits are earned through the successful completion of practical assignments and verified exposure to incident command in an operational environment.

Candidates successfully completing Intermediate ICS Course (100-300, theory) will receive a certificate of completion for the theoretical part of each course. Candidates who complete ICS training will be issued with a Task Book to be completed as evidence of competency.

Once theoretical and practical training are completed successfully candidates will be issued with a certificate of competency.
