

I have applied to study a B.Com. degree. The UFS has accepted me to study for a 4 year B.Com. degree. Why can I not study the B.Com. that I have applied for?

To study a B.Com. degree at the UFS you should have an Achievement Point (AP) of at least 28, as well as Grade 12 Mathematics on level 4 (50%).

You do not meet these requirements because your AP is less than 28 and you should register for the 4 year B.Com. degree.

In this degree you will study 3 development modules in the first year together with three modules from the mainstream B.Com. degree. In the second year you will do the remaining modules of the first year mainstream B.Com. After successfully completing these first two years of the 4 year B.Com. degree, you will be allowed to change to the B.Com. degree of your choice and you will then be on the second year level of that degree.
