I have applied to study B.Com. (accounting). The UFS approved that I may register for a 4 year \B.Com. (Accounting) degree only. Why can I not register for a B.Com. (Accounting)?

To study B.Com. (Accounting) at the UFS you need to have an Achievement point (AP) of 28 at least, as well as Grade 12 Mathematics on level 4 (50%)

Because your AP is less than 28 you do not qualify for B.Com. (Accounting), but because your AP is between 24 and 27 you may register for the 4 year B.Com. (Accounting) degree.

For this degree you will register for 3 development modules in your first study year as well as 3 modules from the first year of a "normal" B.Com. (Accounting) degree. In your second study year you will register for the remaining modules from the first year of normal B.Com. (Accounting) degree. After successfully passing these first two years, you may change to B.Com. (Accounting) and then you will be on the second year level of B.Com. (Accounting).
