I have applied to study a B.Acc. degree. The UFS has accepted me to study B.Com. (Accounting). Why can I not study the B.Acc. degree that I have applied for?

To study a B.Acc. degree at the UFS you should have an Achievement Point (AP) of at least 30, as well as Grade 12 Mathematics on level 5 (60%) and Grade 12 Acounting on level 5 (60%).

You did not meet these requirements.

After successfully completing the first semester of B.Com. (Accounting), the Programme Director will consider your performance and if you obtained at least 60% in Accounting (REK114), he may allow you to change to B.Acc. in the second semester of your first year. You will then change to FIN124 in place of REK124.
