INFORMATION: POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION (degree code: 65400)

The PGDip (Public Administration) is a specialised programme aimed at a career in the public sector, trade unions and nongovernmental organisations. It is structured around public administration and management, with relevant ancillary modules.

Unless otherwise specified, the general regulations regarding PGDip programmes are applicable.

For admission to the PGDip programme, you should have a formal qualification at NQF level 7. You must also have obtained at least and average of 66% for your degree and have passed a language profiency test with at least 56%–59% (level 3).

Prospective students must apply in writing for admission to the programme before 30 April/ 30 September prior to registration in the following semester/year. Application forms are available from the Department of Public Administration and Management or on the university's website. Permission to register for a PGDip programme must be obtained from the Head of the Department prior to registration. Please visit the university's website (<u>www.ufs.ac.za</u>) to download a quotation, using the degree code 65400, and to download an application form and submit it with your other application documents. For any further information, please phone (051) 401 3000.

Students in the PGDip programme must be registered for a minimum of one year.

The PGDip programme consists of 120 credits and the following six modules:

٠	Executive public management	EMMA5825 2 nd semester

- 5) University application form (or DV3 form if you are currently registered at the UFS)
- 6) Two letters of recommendation
