Information: Master of Public Administration (MPA)

Academic plan code: BC674040 Minimum total credits: 186

The MPA programme is an established career-oriented postgraduate programme aimed at high-level management in the Public Sector. It is intended for graduates who have not necessarily had an undergraduate background in public administration or management, but who have gained relevant career experience in the Public Sector or related areas and who want to strengthen their management abilities.

To be admitted to the MPA programme, a student had to obtain at least an average of 65% for his/her bachelor's degree. The student also needs to have at least five years career experience in the Public Sector on a managerial level.

To be able to continue with the mini-dissertation in the second year of study, the student must have achieved an average of 60% for the EPAR7914 (research methodology), or equivalent modules if that student completed his/her studies at another university.

A student for the MPA programme must be registered for a minimum of two years.
