- 1 Please note that the completion of this document does not in any way guarantee admission to the programmes offered by the Department of Quantity Surveying and Construction Management. The selection process takes place before admission. If your application is successful, you will be notified of the results not later than December.
- 2 Complete the DV1A form and attach all the necessary documents as requested on the form. Remember to have all copies certified.
- 3 Pay the necessary application fee. Attach proof of payment to DV1A form (please note, do not send cash, cheques or postal orders - use the banking details as indicated on the front page of the application form).
- 4 Complete the Department of Quantity Surveying and Construction Management selection form.
- 5 Attach certified copies of the following documents:
  - (a) certified copy of senior certificate (Prospective students currently in Grade 12 should provide certified copies of Grade 11 Final and Grade 12 June results).
  - (b) certified copy of previous qualifications and study record (Senior Students).
  - (c) certified copy of Identity Document / Passport

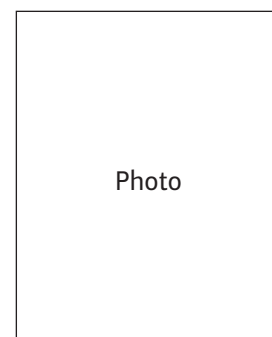
