KRUGER, Elene

Elene Kruger was born in Pietersburg and matriculated in 2001. She obtained a Bachelor of Optometry (BOptom) degree from the then Rand Afrikaans University and a Master of Philosophy (MPhil) in Optometry from the University of Johannesburg. She will be awarded a Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Health Professions Education from the University of the Free State. She is currently a lecturer in the Department of Optometry at the University of the Free State.

With her thesis titled: **A FRAMEWORK FOR COMMUNICATION SKILLS TRAINING OF UNDERGRADUATE OPTOMETRY STUDENTS IN SOUTH AFRICA**, Elene Kruger developed a practical, evidence-informed framework to guide the structured teaching of communication skills within undergraduate optometry programmes. Her study employed a mixed-methods research design, including a national needs analysis of HPCSA-registered optometrists, and Nominal Group Technique sessions with students and lecturers from South African universities offering optometry. Triangulation of findings informed the framework development. The resulting framework provides a systematic and contextually relevant pathway for integrating communication skills training across all years of undergraduate study. It promotes deliberate practice, supports measurable learning outcomes and aligns communication training with professional and patient-care needs. This work makes a significant contribution to health professions education by offering a theoretically grounded, context-specific and replicable model that may be adapted by other health disciplines seeking to enhance communication competence, educational quality and patient care outcomes.

MYBURGH, Michelle Christy

Michelle Myburgh was born in Pretoria. She matriculated at Eunice High School, Bloemfontein in 2002 and obtained her MBChB degree from the University of the Free State in 2009. She completed an MSc in Paediatric Emergency Medicine with distinction at the University of Edinburgh in 2020, a postgraduate diploma in Healthcare Management and Leadership at Eaton Business School in 2021 and a Diploma in Primary Emergency Care in 2023. She serves as an affiliated lecturer in the Department of Paediatrics and Child Health at the University of the Free State. She is the Executive Chair for Paediatric Advanced Life Support (RCSA) and is a member of the ILCOR Paediatric Task Force.



With her thesis titled: **DEVELOPING AN EMERGENCY MEDICINE SIMULATION PROGRAMME WITHIN A PAEDIATRIC POSTGRADUATE CURRICULUM AT THE UNIVERSITY OF THE FREE STATE**, the candidate contributes to scholarship in health professions education, with a focus on locally relevant simulation-based training for postgraduate paediatric emergency care in South Africa. Using a design-based research methodology, the study involved the iterative development, implementation and evaluation of a contextually grounded simulation programme aligned with competency-based education principles. Quantitative data were used alongside qualitative analysis of paediatric registrars' reflective accounts to evaluate learning outcomes and participant experiences. The findings demonstrate that clinically authentic, locally developed simulation-based learning can enhance engagement, support multi-level reflective practice, and facilitate learning transfer to real clinical environments. The study provides a structured framework to inform the development of sustainable, context-appropriate simulation training within South African postgraduate paediatric programmes.

BUTLER, Markes Wayne

Markes Wayne Butler was born in Krugersdorp, Gauteng, on 26 February 1969. He received his secondary education in Randfontein, Gauteng, where he failed, and later matriculated in 1988 at Dr Blok Secondary School, Heidedal, Bloemfontein. He obtained a National Diploma in Emergency Medical Care (2011), Baccalaureus Technologiae in Emergency Medical Care (2012), Magister in Health Professions Education (2014), Baccalaureus Technologiae in Public Management (2015), Postgraduate Diploma in Labour Law (2017) and an Advanced Diploma in Health Management (2022). He began his career as a fireman in Bloemfontein in 1990 and is currently the Director of the Free State Provincial Disaster Management Centre at the Department of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs.

With his thesis titled: **A FRAMEWORK FOR COMMUNITY HEALTH EDUCATION ON CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION AND RESILIENCE: A CASE STUDY OF XHARIEP DISTRICT, FREE STATE PROVINCE**, the candidate makes a substantive contribution to scholarship in public health, climate change adaptation and community resilience. The study develops a contextually grounded framework that strengthens the link between climate policy, health education, and lived realities in vulnerable rural communities. Anchored in the Health Belief Model, Resilience Theory, and Social Learning Theory, the research provides an integrated lens for understanding behavioural, social and structural drivers of adaptation. Using mixed-methods research design, the study identifies significant gaps in climate-health literacy and highlights the limitations of fragmented educational interventions. The findings demonstrate that a culturally embedded, community-driven health education framework offers strong potential to enhance adaptive capacity and support the development of climate-resilient public health systems in high-risk rural districts.

LEDIGA, Manoko Innocentia

Manoko Lediga was raised in Mankweng Township (Turfloop) in the Limpopo Province, South Africa. She matriculated from MP Mamabolo Secondary School in 2011, later earning her BA in 2014 and BA Honours in 2015. She completed a Postgraduate Certificate in Education in 2019 and began working as a high school teacher. In 2022, she obtained her Master's in Transdisciplinary Health and Development Studies, followed by a Postgraduate Diploma in Public Health in 2023. She currently works in research and development at the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences at Stellenbosch University.

With her thesis titled: **A SUPPORT STRATEGY TO IMPROVE ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES FOR PERINATAL WOMEN IN THE LIMPOPO PROVINCE**, the candidate makes a distinguished contribution to scholarship and practice. Written in an article format, the study was conducted in four phases. Phase I comprised a scoping review to map existing evidence. Phases II and III involved exploratory qualitative research, engaging perinatal women and nurses (midwives) to capture lived experiences and contextual insights. Phase IV employed triangulation to integrate findings across methods, ensuring a comprehensive and responsive framework. This rigorous design strengthens health systems research, advances equity in maternal care and bridges the gap between policy and practice. The candidate's work enriches academic discourse while offering actionable strategies to improve access to mental health services for perinatal women, providing sustainable solutions for under-served rural communities in the Limpopo Province and beyond.

MOKHUA, Matieho Belina

Matieho Belina Mokhua was born in Thaba Nchu. She received her secondary education and matriculated at Albert Moroka High School in 2002. She obtained a Bachelor of Optometry in 2007 from the University of Limpopo and a Master of Optometry in 2018 from the University of the Free State. Her interest in low vision led her to complete this PhD in Public Eye Health. She began her career as an optometrist in 2007 and, since 2021, has served as Chief Optometrist at the Free State Department of Health and as a Lecturer at the University of the Free State.

With her thesis titled: **COMMUNICATION AND MOBILISATION FRAMEWORK USED FOR THE HARD-TO REACH VISUALLY IMPAIRED INDIVIDUALS IN THE FREE STATE**, the candidate develops a practical framework to improve communication and mobilisation strategies for hard-to-reach visually impaired individuals in the Free State. Using a mixed-methods design, the study surveyed 398 community health workers (CHWs), conducted in-depth interviews with CHWs, low-vision clinicians and visually impaired participants, and synthesised the findings into a validated implementation framework. Key findings reveal limited CHW training, inconsistent use of structured communication protocols, scarce resources, weak clinician–CHW communication pathways, and barriers to affordable assistive devices. The framework addresses these gaps by recommending structured communication tools, stakeholder mobilisation, resource allocation, and inclusive policy engagement to enhance access to eye care and strengthen patient–provider relationships. The research is evidence-based, contextually grounded, and geared towards informing policy and targeted implementation to improve health outcomes for visually impaired people.

DOCTOR OF PHYSIOTHERAPY

STANDER, Cherezane

Cherezane Stander was born in Bloemfontein on 13 October 1989. She matriculated at Hoërskool Jim Fouché in Bloemfontein in 2007 and obtained the degree BSc Physiotherapy in 2011 (with distinction) and the degree MSc Physiotherapy in 2018, both from the University of the Free State. She started her career as a physiotherapist in Bloemfontein in 2012. In 2017, she was appointed as a junior lecturer in the Department of Physiotherapy at the University of the Free State, where she is currently a lecturer in the same department.

With her thesis titled: **POSTERIOR ANKLE PAIN IN SOUTH AFRICAN BALLET DANCERS**, the candidate contributes to the advancement of knowledge in sports physiotherapy by enhancing the current understanding of posterior ankle pain in dancers. The thesis highlights important gaps in the current understanding of Posterior Ankle Impingement Syndrome (PAIS) and related conditions in dancers, including a lack of standardised diagnostic criteria and limited research on potentially modifiable risk and associated factors. Furthermore, the thesis builds on recent research, expanding the knowledge of the epidemiology of posterior ankle pain in dancers, emphasising important considerations and directions for future research. Finally, the thesis advances our understanding of the implementation of injury prevention programmes (IPPs) in dancer populations by highlighting the importance of not only considering the content of IPPs but also carefully planning their delivery to different end-user groups.

With his thesis titled: **CHARACTERIZATION OF YELLOW FEVER AND ZIKA VIRUS EDIII REGIONS AND ANALYSIS OF SEROLOGICAL CROSS-REACTIVITY**, the candidate makes a contribution to knowledge regarding immunological cross-reactivity of the co-circulating flaviviruses yellow fever and Zika. Using bioinformatics and



protein modelling, the candidate identified potential epitopes within the respective EDIII proteins and identified overlapping epitopic regions that could result in cross-reactive immune responses. The research further investigated cross-reactivity and cross-protection in vitro and by means of a systematic review. The research confirms cross-reactive antibody induction, which was shown to be cross-protective in some cases. The research confirms the potential of yellow fever virus and Zika virus EDIII proteins as vaccine candidates.

Annah Kahari was born on 5 October 1979 in Harare, Zimbabwe. In 2009, she moved to South Africa, where she worked in the NGO sector leading national and regional teams to advance community access to healthcare rights. This study, titled **Protecting Women Migrant Workers' Rights in South Africa: The Need for a Gender-Responsive Framework**, examines the growing feminisation of migration and the distinct vulnerabilities faced by women migrant workers. Although migration offers economic opportunities, many women in South Africa continue to face exploitation, discrimination, precarious employment, and gender-based violence. The study argues that South Africa's gender-neutral migration and labour frameworks fail to address the intersectional risks these workers face, creating a gap between formal legal protection and lived experiences. Drawing on feminist legal theory, intersectionality, and migration theory, the research analyses international, regional and domestic instruments to assess their gender responsiveness. The Gender Legislative Index (GLI) is applied to evaluate South African legislation, revealing significant misalignment with international standards and limited consideration of gendered vulnerabilities. The findings highlight the urgent need for a transformative, gender-responsive legal framework that strengthens protection, enhances enforcement and ensures migrant women's access to justice.

of the right to education amidst harmful cultural practices. With this contribution, she attempts to examine the adequacy of Tanzania's legal and institutional framework to effectively safeguard girls' right to education against harmful cultural practices. Using doctrinal legal analysis complemented by an empirical approach, her study finds that Tanzania's current legal and institutional frameworks are inadequate to protect girls' right to education amid harmful cultural practices. The findings highlight the need for targeted interventions, drawing lessons from Kenya and South Africa, and advocate for constitutional reforms, amendments related to locus standi and public interest litigation, harmonisation and enactment of relevant laws, as well as reforms in institutional frameworks and strategies.
