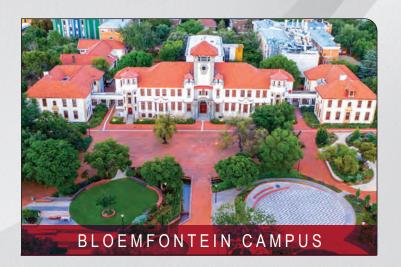

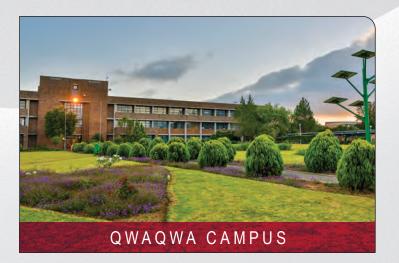
In order to maintain the dignity of the ceremony, you are requested to take note of the following:

It opened its doors in Bloemfontein in **1904** as the Grey University College, with six students in the Humanities. Today it is a multi-campus institution, with two diverse campuses in Bloemfontein and one in Qwaqwa in the scenic Eastern Free State, accommodating more than 40 000 students in its seven faculties (Economic and Management Sciences, Education, Health Sciences, the Humanities, Law, Natural and Agricultural Sciences, Theology and Religion), with an increasing number of international students and associates, and an ever-widening scope of active involvement in and contribution to its surrounding communities.

# DEVELOPMENT OF THE UFS CREST OVER MORE THAN A CENTURY

### 1904

Up to 1935, the same coat of arms was used as the Grey College School.





By 1935, with the name change to University College of the Orange Free State, the coat of arms fell into disuse, especially among students.

### 1947

In 1947, an agreement between management and students led to the new motto Per Fidem ad Sapientiam (Through faith to wisdom).

### 1950

In 1952, it was changed to In Deo Sapientiae Lux (In God is the light of wisdom). The traditional orange, white and blue, linking the UFS to the South African national colours, changed in the late 1990s.

The orange was replaced by cherry red.

The academic brand - the historic University of the Free State crest that has been the symbol of the university since 1952, has evolved to embrace the aesthetic expectations of the stakeholders. The shape of the traditional academic shield has been simplified and contemporised. Much of the symbolism of the crest remains intact, acknowledging the location of the UFS brand as one of the country's premier institutions of higher education, with a proud history of academic excellence and an ever evolving, vibrant culture.

Ha se feela hore le fetoha alumnus setheong sena se seholo sa thuto se nang le dilemo tse 118, empa jwale le boela le fetola karolo mokgatlo wa batho ba hlaheletseng ka mahetla ba ile ba fumantshwa dikgau tsa yunivesithi pele ho wena.

Ditebohiso ho baithuti ba rona ba di-graduate – lena ke letsatsi le kgethileng ka nnete mme dipelo tsa rona di thabile haholo ho bona ba bangata ba lona le fuwa mangolo a lona a tshwaneleho ao le tshwanelehang ho a fumana kajeno. O tlameha ho ikotla sefuba ka sena seo o se fihleletseng – iphe nako ya ho nahana ka mokete ona le ho IKAMOHELA.

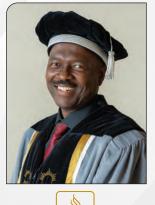

The Department amalgamated with the Department of Anatomy and Cell Morphology to form the Department of Basic Medical Sciences in 2002. She became Head of the Department of Basic Medical Sciences in 2008.

With her thesis, titled: CHRONIC DISEASES OF LIFESTYLE: A RISK ASSESSMENT AND HEALTH PROMOTION FRAMEWORK FOR A RURAL AND URBAN PRIMARY HEALTH CARE SETTING IN THE FREE STATE PROVINCE, the candidate contributes to scholarship on the burden of the chronic diseases of lifestyle (CDL) in the Free State province. With this contribution, she focused on the principles of risk assessment and health promotion in rural and urban communities to minimise the negative impact of CDL. Using a combination of quantitative and qualitative research methods, the candidate identified CDL risk factors in the communities as well as barriers and training needs for the effective implementation of CDL programmes. The study presents a tailor-made community-based patient-centred approach to facilitate the development of focused and effective primary healthcare interventions for CDL in resource-constrained areas of the Free State province.

Keamogetswe Ramonaheng matriculated from Eunice High School, Bloemfontein, in 2000 and obtained her tertiary education at the University of the Free State (UFS). She obtained her B.Med.Sc degree in 2006, followed by a B.Med.Sc (Honours) in 2008. After completing her internship at Universitas Academic Hospital (UAH) in 2010 with a Post-graduate Diploma in Medical Physics, she was appointed as a qualified Medical Physicist and Lecturer in the Department of Medical Physics at the Faculty of Health Sciences, UFS, and promoted to Assistant Manager at UAH in 2011. She completed her M.Med.Sc specialising in Medical Physics for Nuclear Medicine in 2014.

With her thesis, titled: ACCURACY OF LUTETIUM-177 SPECT ACTIVITY QUANTIFICATION AND PATIENT-SPECIFIC DOSIMETRY: A MONTE CARLO STUDY, the candidate makes a valuable contribution to the body of knowledge for personalised dosimetry in radionuclide therapy using hybrid SPECT/CT imaging. The study used patient-specific voxel-based models created from Computed Tomography images and incorporated Monte Carlo simulations of SPECT images to mimic clinically realistic Lutetium-177 activity distribution patient images. These SPECT images allowed her to virtually assess the accuracy of SPECT activity quantification in the simulated patients and thoroughly recognize the many factors related

to patient-specific radionuclide-based therapy planning. This novel method of virtually evaluating the accuracy of activity quantification has enabled the candidate to determine the accuracy of personalised dosimetry for Lutetium-177 radionuclide therapy. The study will benefit future patients receiving Lutetium-177 radionuclide therapy. Thus far, two articles have been published in international accredited journals from this thesis, and a third manuscript has been submitted for publication.

Dedri O'Reilly was born on 23 November 1983 in Bloemfontein. She matriculated at Diamantveld High School in 2001. Since 2008 she has been working as a Medical Physicist on the joint staff establishment of the Department of Health and University of the Free State.

With her thesis, titled: AN IMAGE GUIDED ADAPTIVE RADIOTHERPY STRATEGY FOR CERVIX CANCER TREATMENT BASED ON EQUIVALENT UNIFORM DOSE, the candidate contributes to the knowledge on external beam radiotherapy for cervix cancer patients focusing on designing an approach that balances workload and excellence. Image data of cervix cancer was used to quantify tumor and organ motion. Innovative radiotherapy treatment methods were studied in an attempt to reduce toxicities associated with treatment, while maintaining tumoricidal doses. Several approaches to perform treatment adaptation to a changing tumour environment, while retaining a minimum effort workload, were investigated. The outcomes of this study established several clinically feasible solutions for high quality treatments in both low/high income countries. Even with limited resources, patients can now be treated with exceptional quality techniques, irrespective of the equipment available for this.

He obtained an MBChB at the University of Pretoria in 2003 and an MMed (Haematology) and Postgraduate Diploma (Transfusion Medicine) in 2012 and 2014, respectively, both at the University of the Free State, with distinction. He started his career as a haematologist in Bloemfontein in 2012. He is presently the Head of the Department of Haematology and Cell Biology and the Academic Head of the School of Pathology at NHLS Universitas and the UFS.

With his thesis, titled: CHARACTERISATION OF THE FIBRINOLYTIC SYSTEM AND THE VON WILLEBRAND FACTOR-ADAMTS13 AXIS IN THE CHACMA BABOON, the candidate makes an important contribution to the use of the Chacma

baboon as a preclinical model to study human haemostatic disorders and possible pharmaceutical interventions. Currently, preclinical animal models remain the only viable option to evaluate the safety and efficacy of these drugs before using them in humans. With this study, the largest of its sort ever performed, the candidate characterises similarities and differences between the Chacma baboon and human haemostatic systems and their implications for preclinical haemostatic drug testing. This study validates the use of the Chacma baboon model and provides important recommendations for the refinement of the model, which will allow for the improved evaluation of treatment options of these debilitating and often fatal haemostatic disorders.

THEOLOGY AND RELIGION

With his thesis, titled: **DISSIPELSKAP EN 'N MISSIONALE EKKLESIOLOGIE: 'N ONDERSOEK IN DIE NG KERK** (**DISCIPLESHIP AND A MISSIONAL ECCLESIOLOGY: AN INVESTIGATION IN THE DR CHURCH**), the candidate contributes to the current debate on the role of discipleship in missional ecclesiology. Discipleship is a call from the Trinity to participate in the missio Trinitatis guided by the faith community who leads the disciple on the journey of faith. Discipleship is a lifelong journey of faith for the disciple under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. A mixed methods empirical research was done in six congregations in the Synod of the Free State. The research revealed a few essential markers: the congregation as missional bearer; the missional congregation as partaker in the missio Trinitatis; the disciple as an imago Christi; the ongoing transformation of the disciple, and the disciple as mentee and mentor.

With his thesis, titled: 'LEADING FROM WITHIN: THE SPIRITUALITY AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE CONTEMPLATIVE LEADER', the candidate contributes to the academic discipline of Spirituality by elucidating its relevance, inter alia, in the field of management, business, and leadership. Drawing on the cognate discipline of Contemplative Studies, the candidate clearly explains the relevance of a contemplative spirituality for a new paradigm of leadership. Utilising an interdisciplinary approach, inter alia, Theology, Psychology, and Mysticism, in addition to Spirituality and Contemplative Studies, the candidate illustrates the wider significance of his research for the field of Leadership Studies. His comparison with other leadership styles such as, for example, transactional, charismatic, servant and self-leadership, highlights the particular relevance of contemplative leadership. By providing a conceptual framework for the development of the latter, the candidate contributes to the discipline of Spirituality and its relevance for the Academy and society as a whole.

He obtained a BA (Theological Studies) from Stellenbosch University in 1986, followed by a BTh in 1989, and a MTh in 2004. In 1991, he started his career as a youth worker in Port Elizabeth at the Dutch Reformed Church



Heideveld. In 1992, he was ordained a minister in the Dutch Reformed Church Plettenberg Bay. In 2001, he moved to the Dutch Reformed Church Langenhovenpark, Bloemfontein, where he is still a minister.

With his thesis, titled: SOSIALE MEDIA EN KOINONIA IN GEMEENTES: 'N PRAKTIES TEOLOGIESE STUDIE (SOCIAL MEDIA AND KOINONIA IN CONGREGATIONS: A PRACTICAL THEOLOGICAL STUDY), the candidate contributes to an understanding of the role of social media in the formation of koinonia in congregations. The research explores, through a hermeneutical process, the content of social media posts and people's expectations when visiting these platforms. The empirical research clearly shows that users not only want to receive one-way communication on social media, but also have a need to socialise on these platforms and even experience mutual koinonia. Although a koinonia experience in a digital space may be less intense than in a physical environment, this medium can greatly contribute to individuals, who already have a connection to a physical congregation, experience koinonia. Properly used, social media can definitely contribute to the experience of koinonia in the congregation.

He obtained his Bachelor in Theology (BTh) in 2008, and his Master in Divinity (MDiv) in 2012. He graduated in 2013 (cum laude) and received the Dean's medal as well as the prize for the best mini dissertation. In 2016, he started his Master's in Theology (MTh), with the focus on practical theology and pastoral care. In 2017, he graduated (cum laude) and received the Faculty's prize for the best mini dissertation. In 2018, he started his PhD in practical theology, with the focus on masculinities, genderbased violence, and religious agency. This is a joint degree with the Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam. He successfully defended his thesis in Amsterdam on 2 March 2022.

With his thesis, titled: **TRANSFORMING MASCULINITIES IN THE REFORMED CHURCH IN ZAMBIA: THE GOOD MEN, THE GOOD LIFE, AND THE GOOD NEWS,** the candidate contributes to the field of practical theology by focusing on the intersection of religious agency, gender-based violence, and African masculinities. In his contribution, he attempts to address the causes and effects of gender-based violence in Zambia, by focusing on the practices and beliefs of the Reformed Church in Zambian congregations. The candidate did field work in Zambia following ethnographic and narrative approaches with lived religion and intersectionality as hermeneutical lenses. Four main storylines were identified in the empirical data, and each is countered with a possible "transforming" alternative that imagines new possibilities in a world where gender-based violence is eradicated and equality realised.

# The Main Procession Graduation Gowns – embroidered with rich diversity

outh Africa, and the Free State in particular, has a long-standing friendship with our neighbouring country, Lesotho.

Through a shared history, we have become co-creators of our futures. For this reason, the UFS decided to incorporate our tradition with that of the Basotho in the design of our Main Procession graduation gowns.

The gowns are inspired by the Seanamarena – the traditional Basotho blanket. The different patterns on the Seanamarena indicate the status one holds in the Basotho nation or reflect the occasion being celebrated. Keeping the Seanamarena pattern in mind, we combined our traditional academic designs with that of the Basotho nation.

### YOKE PATTERNS






### Yoke pattern for the Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor

This Seanamarena pattern is an interpretation of a design – used exclusively for the king and chiefs – which means 'to swear by the king'. This blanket has the highest status of all Basotho blankets.

### Yoke pattern for the Chairperson of the Council

This Seanamarena Victorian crest motif appeared after the visit of the Prince of Wales to Lesotho in 1925, which made a profound impression on the local people. Customers refer to this blanket as 'lesiba' – meaning feathers – when buying it.



### Yoke pattern for the Vice-Rector

This Seanamarena Poone design symbolises good crops, wealth, and fertility. The Poone is given as a present to honour an important visitor.



### Yoke pattern for Registrar

The same Seanamarena Poone design used for the Vice-Rector applies to the Registrar, with some slight design and colour alterations.

The Deans wear gowns made in the colours of the faculties, or others which indicate the office they hold.
