Ke le kopa ho dula le ikamahanya le mohlodi ona wa lona wa dikgau tsa thuto, le le boradikgau ba motlotlo.

Le hoja sepheo sa yunivesithi ya rona e nnile ya ba ho le hlomella ka tsebo le ka boitsebelo ba mesebetsi e hlokehang bakeng sa ho etsa diphetoho mafapheng a dithuto tsa lona, re ntse re tseba hore makgabane a molemo ho wena ho etsa diphetoho setjhaheng sa heno. 

#### DIPPENAAR, Zané

Zané Dippenaar was born in Bloemfontein on the 5th of November 1994. She obtained Bachelor of Commerce Degree in Marketing (2015), and Honours Degree in Marketing with distinction (2016). She also completed a Master of Commerce in Business Management (2018) and Doctor of Philosophy in Business Management (2025) at the University of the Free State. She started her career as Marketing and Innovation Strategist at the Directorate Research Development (DRD) Department, University of the Free State in Bloemfontein in 2017 and she is currently the Head of Marketing and Growth Projects at the IBC SOLAR South Africa, in Cape Town.

With her thesis titled: **ADVERTISING AND BRAND LOYALTY IN THE SOUTH AFRICAN SOLAR INDUSTRY**, the candidate focused on the moderated mediation effect of brand awareness on the relationship between advertising and brand loyalty. Using a positivist research paradigm and a quantitative research methodology, she surveyed 427 solar installation companies subscribed to IBC SOLAR's platforms in South Africa. The study found that below-the-line advertising did not directly influence brand loyalty. However, competitive advantage and commitment positively impacted brand loyalty, particularly at higher levels of brand awareness. Trust was not a significant predictor of brand loyalty. These findings suggest that in the competitive South African solar market, companies that enhance their competitive edge and commitment, supported by strong brand awareness, are more likely to achieve greater brand loyalty. The study provides valuable insights for business-to-business solar distributors seeking to enhance customer loyalty.

His career began as a private-sector administrator before joining the Department of Labour as an HR Practitioner and later becoming Assistant Director. He was Deputy Director of Programme Management at the Department of Tourism and currently manages Chain Management at the Department of Public Works and Infrastructure.

With his thesis titled: **A STRATEGIC PROCUREMENT FRAMEWORK IN SUSTAINING THE CONSTRUCTION SECTOR: A CASE OF KWAZULU-NATAL SMMEs**, the candidate makes a contribution to scholarship in public procurement and the SMME sector by proposing a strategic procurement framework for developing and sustaining SMMEs in the construction sector. Using a mixed-method approach with 20 expert public service officials and 527 SMME owners, the study examines BBBEE empowerment elements, human capital, and the influence of ICT in sustaining construction SMMEs in South Africa. The study highlights gaps in the monitoring and evaluation of

contractor development programmes (CDP) and argues that the 30-day public sector payment period is unsuitable for the programme. Findings suggest the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) adopt a staggered contractor grading approach to upgrade and manage contractors. It also recommends that government institutions ensure their departmental structures are adequately equipped with professionally trained officials to manage the contractor development programme effectively.

Through an explorative case study in Zambia, Daizy employed the capability approach to understand the valued opportunities and freedoms necessary for environmental sustainability. Her study illuminates the voices of lecturers, students, graduates, and environmental policy institutions, arguing that environmental issues, though global, are highly contextual, necessitating an educational response that addresses these complexities. The study proposes a capability-based framework for environmental education aimed at environmental sustainability and identifies various opportunities and freedoms essential for driving the anticipated changes. Her study makes an original theoretical contribution by identifying eco-capabilities that higher education should foster to enhance both individual and collective actions towards environmental sustainability.

Judith sampled 58 participants – comprising students, lecturers, and key informants – from a selected university in Zimbabwe to analyse how the Education 5.0 policy constrains or enables opportunities and freedoms for human development in teaching and learning. Although Education 5.0 has the potential to boost employment opportunities in Zimbabwe, its successful implementation has been hindered by a lack of financial, human, technological, and material resources, exacerbated by the country's economic limitations. The study advocates for a 21st century, human development-focused university, emphasising the need for holistic teaching and learning processes that promote economic, political, and social freedoms for critical citizenship rather than focusing on a single dimension only.

He later joined the Copperbelt University in 2011 as a lecturer in the Department of Economics, teaching macroeconomics, public finance, and economic development.

With his thesis titled: **GLOBAL ECONOMIC SHOCKS AND MACROECONOMIC PERFORMANCE IN ZAMBIA: ASSESSING VULNERABILITY AND POLICY OPTIONS**, the candidate makes a contribution to the literature on macroeconomic volatility in developing countries, focusing specifically on the case of Zambia. Using novel and advanced econometric methods, particularly the Structural VARX, Bayesian VARX, and Global VAR model, the study reveals a vulnerability of the Zambian economy to commodity price shocks, external demand shocks, and international monetary policy spillovers emanating from major advanced and regional economies. The study further underscores the transformative power of informed policy responses by harnessing a combination of fiscal and monetary policy and structural reforms to diversify the Zambian economy.

finance to under- and postgraduate students at the University of the Free State. He has also lectured internationally at the University of Bremen, Germany.

With his thesis titled: **MARKET EFFICIENCY AND SHARE PRICE REACTION FOLLOWING THE RETROSPECTIVE RESTATEMENT OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS OF JSE-LISTED COMPANIES**, the candidate examines market efficiency by analysing both short-term and medium-to-long-term share price reactions to financial restatements. A key contribution of the study is the distinction between four categories of restatements—new accounting standards, changes in accounting policy, prior period errors, and JSE Financial Reporting Investigation Panel (FRIP) recommendations—providing insights into their respective market impacts. The analysis, based on 268 JSE-listed companies over a ten-year period, reveals that while the market demonstrates semi-strong efficiency for restatements due to new accounting standards, inefficiencies persist in other categories, increasing information asymmetry and investor uncertainty. The study applies multiple abnormal return estimation models to ensure robust results and offers valuable insights for investors, regulators, and policymakers to enhance financial reporting transparency and regulatory oversight in emerging markets.

She subsequently qualified as a chartered accountant (CA(SA)) at the beginning of 2015. She started her career in academia and received her M.Acc. in Accountancy in 2018, which was focused on sugar tax.

With her thesis titled: **TAXATION AS A METHOD TO PROMOTE SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE IN SOUTH AFRICA**, the candidate contributes to scholarship by having identified guidelines that are attributable to the main objectives of sustainable agriculture, which assisted in guiding the identification of tax provisions that could be said to promote sustainable agriculture. Empirically, this study is the first to provide empirical evidence regarding the possible use of specific tax provisions in promoting sustainable agriculture in South Africa. Insight was also gained as to the main reasons why agricultural producers have not yet invested in more sustainable options such as renewable energy. Areas for future innovation were also identified. At the policy level, the findings of this study support the development and implementation of tax provisions that can guide policymakers in crafting effective tax legislation in order to promote sustainable agriculture in South Africa.
