Ke le kopa ho dula le ikamahanya le mohlodi ona wa lona wa dikgau tsa thuto, le le boradikgau ba motlotlo.

Le hoja sepheo sa yunivesithi ya rona e nnile ya ba ho le hlomella ka tsebo le ka boitsebelo ba mesebetsi e hlokehang bakeng sa ho etsa diphetoho mafapheng a dithuto tsa lona, re ntse re tseba hore makgabane a molemo ho wena ho etsa diphetoho setjhhabeng sa heno. 



FORMER CHIEF JUSTICE: RAYMOND MNYAMEZELI MLUNGISI ZONDO

later returned to the High Court in Pretoria (2010–2012). In September 2012, he was appointed as a Justice of the Constitutional Court, followed by his appointment as Deputy Chief Justice in 2017. He served as Chairperson of the State Capture Commission in 2018 and was appointed Chief Justice of the Republic of South Africa in April 2022. He retired in August 2024.

Justice Zondo has received numerous accolades, including the Sydney and Felicia Kentridge Award for service to law in Southern Africa. He has been conferred honorary LLD degrees by Rhodes University (March 2023) and the University of South Africa (September 2023) in recognition of his contributions to the field.

Former Chief Justice Raymond Mnyamezeli Mlungisi Zondo was born in Ixopo, KwaZulu-Natal. He completed his secondary and high school education at St Mary's Seminary, matriculating in 1980. He pursued higher education at the University of Zululand, the University of Natal (now the University of KwaZulu-Natal), and the University of South Africa, earning a B.luris (UniZul), an LLB (UKZN), and three LLM degrees from UNISA: one cum laude in Labour Law, another specialising in Commercial Law, and a third in Patent Law.

Justice Zondo served part of his articles of clerkship under Mrs Victoria Mxenge before her assassination by apartheid agents. After completing his articles, he practised as an attorney for several years and was a member of the Ministerial Task Team that drafted the Labour Relations Bill, which was later enacted as the Labour Relations Act of 1995. In 1999, he was appointed as a Judge of the High Court in Pretoria. He went on to serve as Judge-President of the Labour Appeal Court (2000–2010) and
