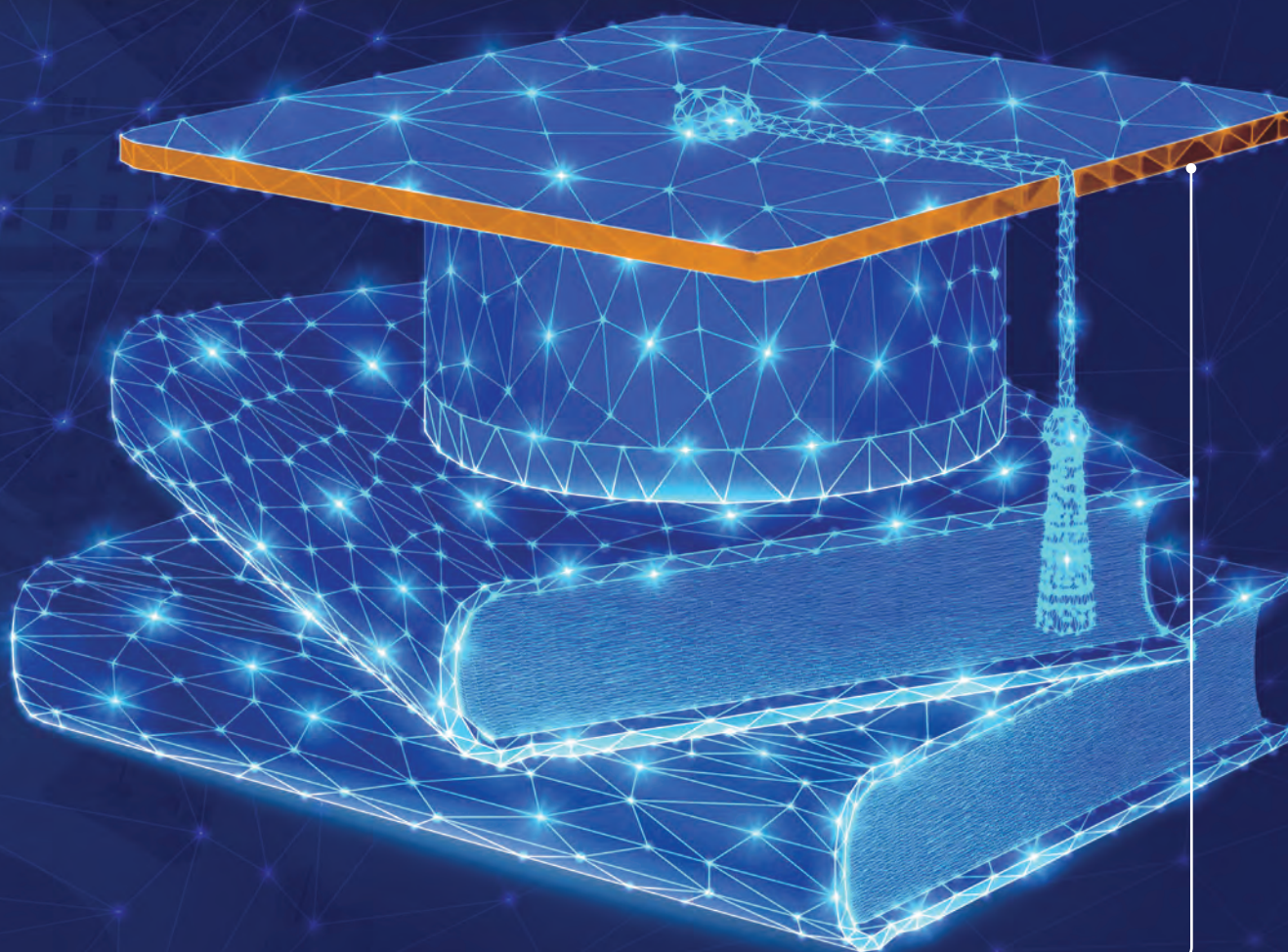

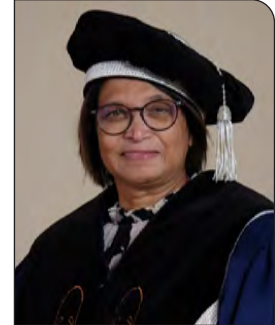

JOHANNES DE VILLIERS



GUEST SPEAKER

Johannes de Villiers began his tertiary education at Stellenbosch University (SU) in 1996 when he enrolled for a BA in Journalism, followed by an honours degree in the same discipline. In 2000, he completed a second honours degree in French and returned to postgraduate studies in 2008 when he completed a master's degree in Hebrew Literature (focusing on ancient Gnosticism) at SU.

He started working as a journalist at Rapport (Sunday paper) in 2001 and then the Cape Town-based newspaper *Die Burger* before becoming an editorial member of *Huisgenoot/YOU*. During his career, he also worked for *Gulf News* in Dubai and lectured in practical journalism, science journalism, and cultural literacy in the SU Department of Journalism. In 2013 and 2014, he held the Rykie van Reenen research chair at the same institution.

Parallel to his tertiary education and journalism career, De Villiers became a mediation and mindfulness student at the Robertson Dharma

Centre in 2001 and was certified as a meditation instructor in 2017. He gained global experience in Asia and the USA before settling in the Free State to pursue his purpose.

De Villiers is currently an author and mindfulness teacher based in Bloemfontein. He designs and teaches courses and classes on mindfulness, positive psychology, and post-traumatic growth. He is the author of three books about mindfulness (*Kalmte in die Malle Gejaag*, *Blydskap*, and *Meer as Jou Seerkry*) and the presenter of *Vol Vreugde*, a programme on national Afrikaans radio broadcaster RSG, focusing on the psychology of happiness. His debut novel is scheduled for publication by Human & Rousseau in July 2025.
