IDA MANANA SIYILA SCHOLARSHIP 2022

The Scholarship will be available for the minimum required time to achieve the Bachelors qualification (typically 3-4 years dependent on the qualification) but not exceeding six years.

It is open to previously disadvantaged female learners who (1) matriculated from schools in the Free State Province in 2021, who (2) are South African citizens and who have (3) been accepted for a degree course at the University of the Free State.

The Scholarship recognises both academic performance and leadership through service. The Scholarship covers registration fees, tuition, residence/accommodation fees including meals, and books. The Scholarship is renewable each year and requires that the student passes at least 80% of the modules each year for the scholarship to be renewed.

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Applicants Selection Criteria

- The programme is open to previously disadvantaged female learners who matriculated from schools in the Free State Province in 2021, who are South African citizens and who will study a degree course at the University of the Free State.
- Evidence of community service or leadership during their school career
- Students must come from a family where the combined annual income is less than R600 000 in 2021 a year (before tax, and including all Grants, Pensions, salaries etc). Orphaned or emancipated applicants must supply official certified documentation of their status. Students eligible for NSFAS will not be considered.
- Students must be academically superior they must have obtained a Bachelor level pass with an UFS Admission Point (AP-score) of at least 36.
- They must have been accepted to the University of Free State to study within any faculty of their choice.
