- Copy of report for final school term in 2024
- Letter of confirmation of good conduct from the school and confirmation of the school quintile
- Letter from the school confirming exemption/discount and amount of bursary/exemption/discount (if applicable)

Student Applicant Documents

- 2025 Proof of registration
- Copy of transcript for mid term 2025
- Copy of transcript for mid term and year end 2024 (if applicable)
