ABOUT THE UFS

The University of the Free State (UFS) is one of the oldest institutions of higher education in South Africa.

It opened its doors in 1904 in Bloemfontein as the Grey University College, with six students in the Humanities. Since then, the institution has grown to more than 40 000 students, spread over three campuses and across seven faculties (Economic and Management Sciences, Education, Health Sciences, the Humanities, Law, Natural and Agricultural Sciences, Theology and Religion).

Most of the students are located on the Bloemfontein Campus, with the Qwaqwa Campus situated in the picturesque Eastern Free State, serving a rapidly-growing number of rural students from the immediate area and surrounding provinces. The South Campus – also situated in Bloemfontein – serves as the centre for distance-learning programmes offered by the UFS, as well as alternative access to higher education for promising students who have not obtained the required marks in their final school examinations.

Over the years, the university has grown into an education hub which has positioned itself on the global stage, promoting research excellence, with exceptionally talented scholars and students who are recognised the world over, as well as alumni who have grown into influential leaders in society.



DEVELOPMENT OF THE UFS CREST OVER MORE THAN A CENTURY



1904

Up to 1935, the same coat of arms was used as the Grey College School.



1935

By 1935, with the name change to University College of the Orange Free State, the coat of arms fell into disuse, especially among students.



1947

In 1947, an agreement between management and students led to the new motto Per Fidem ad Sapientiam (Through faith to wisdom).



1950

In 1952, it was changed to In Deo Sapientiae Lux (In God is the light of wisdom). The traditional orange, white and blue, linking the UFS to the South African national colours, changed in the late 1990s. The orange was replaced by cherry red.



2011

The academic brand – the historic University of the Free State crest that has been the symbol of the university since 1952, has evolved to embrace the aesthetic expectations of the stakeholders. The shape of the traditional academic shield has been simplified and contemporised. Much of the symbolism of the crest remains intact, acknowledging the location of the UFS brand as one of the country's premier institutions of higher education, with a proud history of academic excellence and an ever evolving, vibrant culture.

Youngest Female PhD Graduate in Africa (2017)



Dr Musawenkosi Donia Saurombe is an academic making waves in the academic sphere. She obtained a Doctor of Philosophy in Industrial Psychology in 2017, setting an astounding academic record by becoming the youngest female PhD graduate in Africa at the age of 23. Dr Saurombe worked as a Postdoctoral Research Fellow and Lecturer at

the North-West University in Mafikeng from April 2017 and was appointed as a Senior Lecturer at the University of the Free State in Bloemfontein in April 2019. Dr Saurombe lectures courses in Human Resource Management and Industrial Psychology, and supervises postgraduate research and is an eminent civic innovator.

In 2017, Dr Saurombe received the award for Best Doctoral Student in South Africa for 2016 from the South African Board for People's Practices (SABPP), and the Emerging Psychologist of the Year award from the Society for Industrial and Organisational Psychology of South Africa

(SIOPSA). She was featured in the Africa Youth Awards' 2018 List of Top 100 Most Influential Young Africans, and recently received the Institute of People Management (IPM) CEO's Special Award as the 2018 Young Leader of the Year for various outstanding contributions in her field. She was also acknowledged by *The Young Independents* (TYI) as one of the SADC Top 100 of 2018 at the 100 Awards in December 2018. Although Dr Saurombe is still at the beginning of her academic career, she has already shown great promise as a future researcher and academic of note. The future looks bright for the young emerging powerhouse, to say the least.

Calvin Mudzingiri was born on 10 November 1974 in Zaka District, Masvingo Province, Zimbabwe. He attained a diploma in Education at Mutare Teachers' College in 1998. He graduated with a BSc Honours degree in Economics in 2004 and an MSc degree in Economics in 2010 at the University of Zimbabwe. He was a teacher in the Ministry of Education from between 1991 and 2004. He was an Economist in the Ministry of Agriculture from 2005 until 2008 after which he joined the Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe as an analyst until 2011. He joined the University of the Free State in 2012 where he is the Assistant Dean in the Faculty of Economic and Management Sciences on the Qwaqwa campus.

With his thesis titled: ***THE IMPACT OF FINANCIAL LITERACY ON RISK AND TIME PREFERENCES AND FINANCIAL BEHAVIOURAL INTENTIONS***, the candidate contributes to scholarship on Behavioural and Experimental Economics, focusing on how financial literacy impacts the risk preferences, time preferences and financial behaviour of university students. Mudzingiri collected data from 192 university students by way of a questionnaire, multiple price list time preferences and risk preferences experimental tasks, financial literacy test as well as a binary choice time preference task. The study examined whether there are differences in financial behaviour, confidence level, risk preferences and time preferences of university students with high financial literacy when compared to those students with low financial literacy. Low financial literacy level university students were found to be more risk loving, overconfident, more impatient and indecisive in making choices when compared to university students with high financial literacy. High financial literacy is associated with a patient attitude.

Maseeeng Papashane was born on 28 March 1982 in Kroonstad. In 1999, she matriculated at Treverton College. She obtained her BA degree in 2003 from Rhodes University, BA Honours degree in Psychology, and BA Honours degree in Sociolinguistics at Unisa in 2005 and 2009 respectively. She also obtained a PGCE with distinction and an MA degree from the University of the Free State in 2006 and 2014 respectively. Her career at the University of the Free State started in 2006. She left in 2018 to join Sol Plaatje University where she is presently a lecturer.

With her thesis titled ***ENHANCING COHESION AND COHERENCE IN ACADEMIC ESSAY WRITING OF SENIOR UNDERGRADUATE EDUCATION STUDENTS***, the candidate contributes to scholarship on academic essay-writing studies among senior undergraduate Education students who are additional-language users of English. Using participatory action research in this qualitative study, Papashane and five senior undergraduate Education student co-researchers engaged in a free attitude focus-group discussion. The students provided reflective academic essay-writing self-narratives to explore their personal journeys in academic essay writing in Education at the senior undergraduate level. The findings reveal conceptualisations, approaches, enabling conditions, threats, and strategies regarding enhancing cohesion and coherence in academic essay writing. Ultimately, Papashane proposes a framework of concurrent and multipronged stakeholder participation. The major implication of the proposed framework is that academic essay writing among senior undergraduate Education students may be developed optimally in a systemic approach, capitalising on intra-institutional resources.

South Africa, and the Free State in particular, has a long-standing friendship with our neighbouring country, Lesotho.

Through a shared history, we have become co-creators of our futures. For this reason, the UFS decided to incorporate our tradition with that of the Basotho in the design of our Main Procession graduation gowns.

The gowns are inspired by the Seanamarena – the traditional Basotho blanket. The different patterns on the Seanamarena indicate the status one holds in the Basotho nation or reflect the occasion being celebrated. Keeping the Seanamarena pattern in mind, we combined our traditional academic designs with that of the Basotho nation.

YOKE PATTERNS

Yoke pattern for the Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor

This Seanamarena pattern is an interpretation of a design – used exclusively for the king and chiefs – which means “to swear by the king”. This blanket has the highest status of all Basotho blankets.



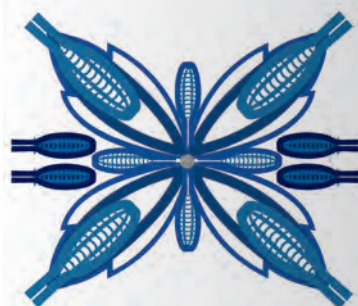
Yoke pattern for the Chairperson of the Council

This Seanamarena Victorian crest motif appeared after the visit of the Prince of Wales to Lesotho in 1925, which made a profound impression on the local people. Customers refer to this blanket as ‘lesiba’ – meaning feathers – when buying it.



Yoke pattern for the Vice-Rector

This Seanamarena Poone design symbolises good crops, wealth, and fertility. The Poone is given as a present to honour an important visitor.



Yoke pattern for Registrar

The same Seanamarena Poone design used for the Vice-Rector applies to the Registrar, with some slight design and colour alterations.

The Deans wear gowns made in the colours of the faculties or others which indicate the office they hold.
