Step 5: Set Proxy Server



Step 6: Close the browser to let the configuration take effect.

Step 7: Reopen the Browser and start with the logins <u>ufs.ac.za</u> or <u>learn.ufs.ac.za</u>

Note if these settings are done within IE Explorer and you have a Chrome browser these settings will also be inherited into the Chrome browser.

To reset old settings: Unclick the tick box in the Proxy Settings box. Then click both click boxes as deactivated in step 1 under Automatic Configuration. Click ok. Close the browser and restart. This will be required if the student want to view YouTube and Social Media or other browsing is required
