

Accommodation arrangements for students who have qualified for renewal of placement First Semester 2021

Kindly note the following important information:

- Return to campus is determined by the blended teaching and learning arrangements of faculties.
- If your faculty have identified you to return to campus for face-to-face teaching you need to keep the following in mind, prior to starting your journey back to campus:
 - You must have completed the registration process (8-26 February 2021) successfully – only registered students will be welcomed onto campus and in residences;
 - Your faculty must have issued you with a valid Access Permit, confirming a date of arrival;
 - You must have received written confirmation from Housing and Residence Affairs (HRA) that you may return for residence accommodation.

Due to the requirements for face-to-face teaching, certain faculties have decided to invite students to campus for short periods only, also referred to as block sessions (mostly 1-3 weeks), in some instances for 1-3 months. Certain students will be invited back to campus for the full first semester.

For this reason the University will implement a blended model accommodation approach, as from 1 March 2021. This model entails the following:

- Short stay accommodation: available to students who have been invited to campus for short periods, i.e, block and contact sessions.
- **Semester accommodation**: available to students who have been identified to return to campus for the full first semester.

Short stay accommodation (Available from 1 March 2021)

Students who have been identified to come to campus for short periods may apply for accommodation in identified residences on each campus.

- Short stay accommodation is open to any student (residence and non-residence) as long as you are registered and have received a valid Access Permit.

Semester accommodation (Only available to students who have qualified for renewal of placement for 2021)

Students who have been identified to return to campus for the duration of the first semester will be able to make use of accommodation in their respective residences.

- Semester accommodation implies that you are responsible for the normal accommodation fee for the first semester;
- A six month accommodation(template) contract as well as an undertaking will be signed prior to a students' return to campus;

- The accommodation fees will be charged to your student account;
- Residences will open over the weekend of 26-28 February 2021.

Students who want to make use of semester accommodation:

- Must indicate their intent to accept the offer for a six-month contract by clicking on the respective campus
 - o Bloemfontein Campus
 - o South Campus
 - o Qwaqwa Campus
- Students will be redirected to a form which will be completed online;
- Submitting the online form will create an automatic email to <u>resapplications@ufs.ac.za</u>
- Upon receiving the email HRA will finalise the booking and sent a confirmation letter to the student.

Students who have qualified for renewal of placement but who are not invited back to campus – suspension of renewal of placement for six months:

- Students will be afforded the opportunity to suspend their renewal for 2021 until the start of the 2nd semester;
- The decision to suspend the renewal of placement for six months will be captured by clicking on the respective campus
 - o Bloemfontein Campus
 - o South Campus
 - <u>Qwaqwa Campus;</u>
- Students will be redirected to a form which will be completed online;
- Submitting the online form will create an automatic email to resapplications@ufs.ac.za
- Upon receiving the email HRA will capture the decision to suspend the renewal of placement and acknowledge the student's decision.
- Continuation of accommodation the second semester 2021

Please note submission of renewal or suspension to be done no later than 5 March 2021
