Communique to all residence students

Given the announcement of the Minister of Higher Education on Wednesday 26 August 2020, arrangements with regard to residence accommodation from 1 September 2020 will entail the following:

- Kindly note residences are currently being cleaned (only public areas) and prepared to welcome back students for the second semester.
- Students who have received an invitation to return may return to their respective residences after Wednesday 2 September 2020.
- Students who have received an invitation to return must ensure that they do have the Student Access Permit and that they have informed their residence head prior to the start of their journey back to campus.
- The principle of one-student-per-room, if possible, will still apply. Residence heads will reallocate students who are roommates if both students are returning.
- Due to the huge amount of system related changes (booking changes, re-doing the move in and move out date etc.) students may experience a delay with regards to access via their student cards.

Important:

The following COVID-19 protocols are still in place and will be managed by the Residence Head with the support of the RC:

- Maintain social/physical distancing.
- Wear a face mask at all times when leaving the room or building.
- Wash hands as often as possible.
- Adhere to the nightly curfew 22:00-05:00.
- Sign the "Undertaking" to be provided by the residence head upon arrival.
- Adhere to the rules especially regarding visitors, no visitors from outside residence are allowed.
