## Frequently asked questions about our **EDED** modules

What is the purpose of this module?	To <b>enhance students' employability</b> and position our UFS graduates uniquely in the job market.  To create a space for students to intentionally <b>reflect</b> on their learning across the modules in their degree programme and make the required links between modules to <b>synthesise</b> their <b>learning and development</b> in the form of <b>ePortfolios</b> .
Will classes be online or F2F?	Classes will be conducted <b>F2F</b> .
Is it a semester or year module?	EDED3712 (first semester) and EDED3722 (second semester) are equivalent <b>semester</b> modules.
Which module should students register for?	Students should register for <b>only one of the following modules, and not both</b> , as they are the same content: <b>EDED3712</b> is presented in a summer school in the first semester. <b>EDED3722</b> is presented in a winter school in the second semester.
Who can register for this module?	Final-year undergraduate and postgraduate students
How can students register for the module?	Students who wish to register for our EDED modules should <b>contact</b> their <b>faculty</b> advising team, who will advise on the appropriate method of registration agreed upon by their faculty.
When will classes take place?	Each <b>faculty</b> has selected <b>specific dates</b> for their students to attend classes. After registration, students can expect further communication from the EDED team regarding dates allocated to them to attend classes. Alternatively, students can contact their faculty to inquire.
How will the module be set up?	Students attend classes over <b>2.5 days</b> . Thereafter, additional support is provided to assist students with completing and submitting <b>assignments</b> over the course of the semester. There are <b>no exams</b> .
Will failing this module prevent students from graduating?	This module has no bearing on your degree program, therefore failing will not prevent students from graduating.
Do students need to pay for this module?	These modules are fully funded. Therefore, <b>students do not pay</b> for any EDED modules. Once registered, the fee for the module will be debited, and then discounted (credited) on your tuition fee account.
